In my many years of teaching history I've often found that the biggest problem students have is that they have little or no knowledge about basic concepts as simple as what governments do, what economics is, and how societies are organized among other things.

Students will also be introduced to how to use and evaluate historical sources as well as employ basic graphic organizers to help arrange and analyze information.
