Lamadrid, 2019-12-01 Naci n Gen zara examines the history cultural evolution and survival of the Gen zaro people The contributors to this volume cover topics including ethnogenesis slavery settlements poetics religion gender family history and mestizo genetics Fray Ang lico Ch vez defined Gen zaro as the ethnic term given to indigenous people of mixed tribal origins living among the Hispano population in Spanish fashion They entered colonial society as captives taken during wars with Utes Apaches Comanches Kiowas Navajos and Pawnees Gen zaros comprised a third of the population by 1800 Many assimilated into Hispano and Pueblo society but others in the land grant communities maintained their identity through ritual self government and kinship Today the persistence of Gen zaro identity blurs the lines of distinction between Native and Hispanic frameworks of race and cultural affiliation This is the first study to focus exclusively on the detribalized Native experience of the Gen zaro in New Mexico

Joaquín Rivaya-Martínez, 2023-04-20 Pervasive myths of European domination and indigenous submission in the Americas receive an overdue corrective in this far reaching revisionary work Despite initial upheavals caused by the European intrusion Native people often thrived after contact preserving their sovereignty territory and culture and shaping indigenous borderlands across the hemisphere Borderlands in this context are spaces where diverse populations interact cross cultural exchanges are frequent and consequential and no polity or community holds dominion Within the indigenous borderlands of the Americas as this volume shows Native peoples exercised considerable power often retaining control of the land and remaining paramount agents of historical transformation after the European incursion Conversely European conquest and

black land ownership political participation and business ownership The church he founded Bethel Missionary Baptist Church in Tallahassee would go on to be a major political force not only during Reconstruction but through today Based upon numerous archival sources and personal papers as well as an in depth interview of James Page and a reflection on his life by a contemporary this deeply researched book brings to light a fascinating life filled with contradictions concerning gender education and the social interaction between the races Rivers biography of Page is an important addition and corrective to our understanding of black spirituality and religion political organizing and civic engagement

Puebloan Societies Peter M.
