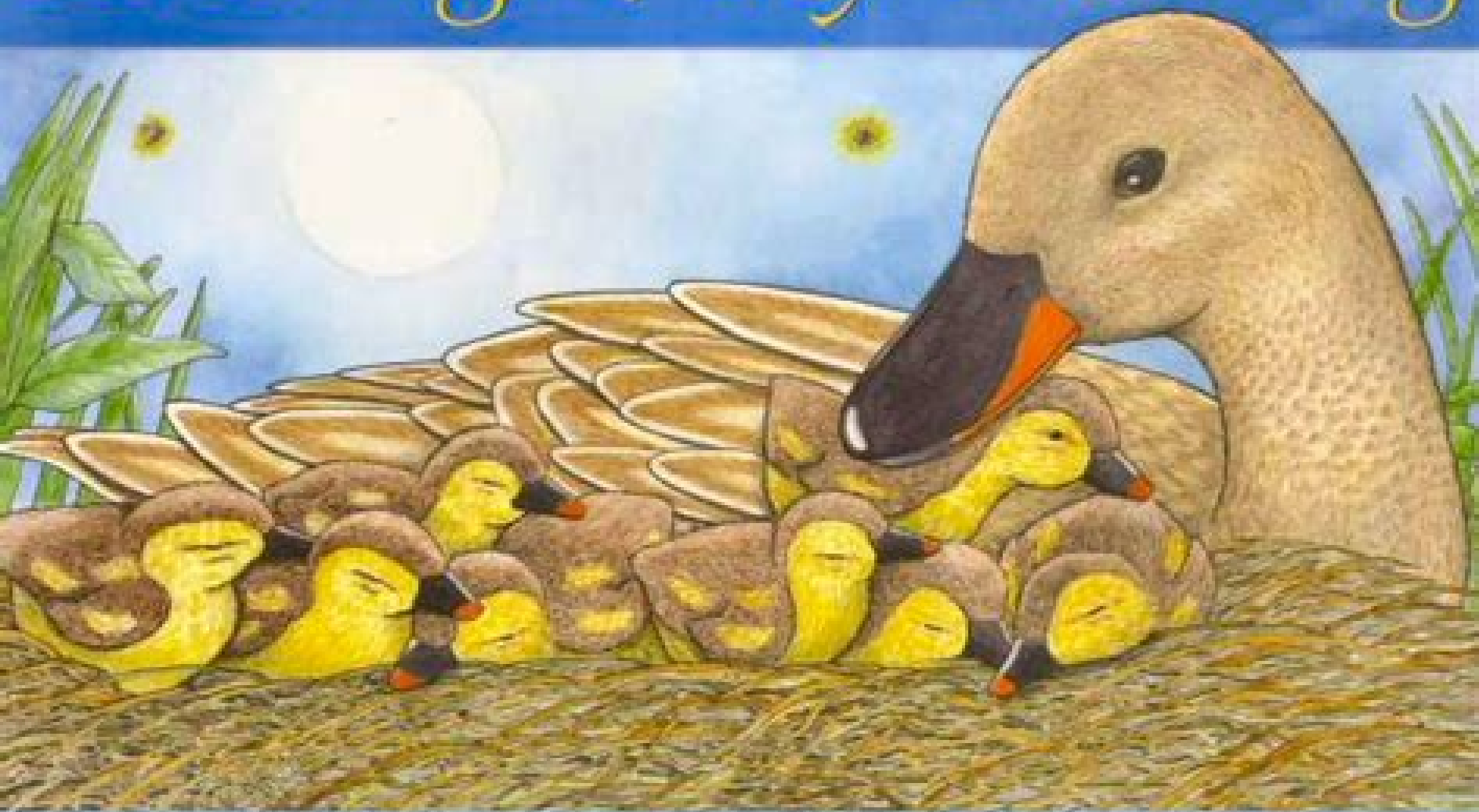

Toddler Storytimes II Diane Briggs, 2008 School Library Journal With 25 theme based chapters this is a handy resource Each theme includes book recommendations often 10 or more with a nice mixture of classic and newer titles and a suggestion to choose two or three per session Words and instructions for fingerplays rhymes and songs are provided while a discography provides melody sources for all songs Each theme includes a flannel board activity complete with reproducible patterns and brief directions on how to present the story or song on the board Safe and simple crafts ideas are presented as optional activities Activities are listed by type rather than in an ordered list so tellers can pick choose and order according to individual style and preference An introduction provides tips and rationale for all of the types of activities A couple of sentences note the potential impact on brain development and early literacy skills but the focus is on the activities themselves strategies for sharing early literacy information with parents and caregivers are not addressed Judy Nichols's *Storytimes for Two Year Olds* ALA 2007 and Linda L Ernst's *Baby Rhyming Time* Neal Schuman 2008 provide more

comprehensive looks at all aspects of storytime planning and presentation This update of Briggs s Toddler Storytime Programs Scarecrow 1993 will be most useful as a resource for programming ideas and fleshing out themes **A to Zoo** Rebecca L.
