Twenty-eight bodies were recovered, most of them boys from Henley's neighborhood, making this the worst case of serial murder in America at the time. The case reveals gross failures in the way cops handled parents' pleas to look for their missing sons and how law enforcement possibly protected a larger conspiracy.
