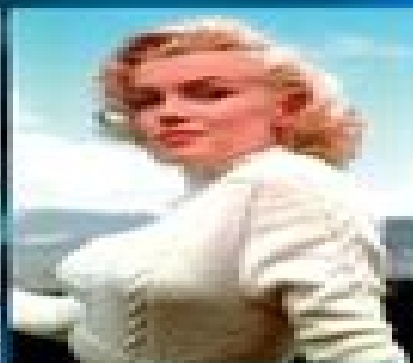

Walker, Jennifer Wise, 2003-07-09 The Broadview Anthology of Drama Plays from the Western Theatre is a chronological presentation of 43 plays in two volumes ranging from the ancient theatre world to the present day Each chapter focuses on a specific period and begins with an insightful introduction sketching the historical and theatrical landscape of that period Contextualization for each play is provided through a thorough account of the literary and dramatic background of the play along with clear and comprehensive annotation In addition the editors have provided a glossary of terms used in the anthology to better equip students with a vocabulary for discussing the world of the stage

A People's Tragedy Eamon Duffy, 2020-11-26 As an authority on the religion of medieval and early modern England Professor Eamon Duffy is preeminent In his revisionist masterpiece *The Stripping of the Altars* Duffy opened up new areas of research and entirely fresh perspectives on the origin and progress of the English Reformation Duffy's focus has always been on the practices and institutions through which ordinary people lived and experienced their religion but which the Protestant reformers abolished as idolatry and superstition The first part of *A People's Tragedy* examines the two most important of these institutions the rise and fall of pilgrimage to the cathedral shrines of England and the destruction of the monasteries under Henry VIII as exemplified by the dissolution of the ancient Anglo Saxon monastery of Ely In the title essay of the volume Duffy tells the harrowing story of the Elizabethan regime's savage suppression of the last Catholic rebellion against the Reformation the Rising of the Northern Earls in 1569 In the second half of the book Duffy considers the changing ways in which the Reformation has been thought and written about the evolution of Catholic portrayals of Martin Luther from hostile caricature to partial approval the role of historians of the Reformation in the emergence of English national identity and the improbable story of the twentieth century revival of Anglican and Catholic pilgrimage to the medieval Marian shrine of Walsingham Finally he considers the changing ways in which attitudes to the Reformation have been reflected in fiction culminating with Hilary Mantel's gripping trilogy on the rise and fall of Henry VIII's political and religious fixer Thomas Cromwell and her controversial portrayal of Cromwell's Catholic opponent and victim Sir Thomas More

Lycurgan Athens and the Making of Classical Tragedy Johanna Hanink, 2014-06-19 Through a series of interdisciplinary studies this book argues that the Athenians themselves invented the notion of classical tragedy just a few generations after the city's defeat in the Peloponnesian War In the third quarter of the fourth century BC and specifically during the Lycurgan Era 338-322 BC a number of measures were taken in Athens to affirm to the Greek world that the achievement of tragedy was owed to the unique character of the city By means of rhetoric architecture inscriptions statues archives and even legislation the classical tragedians Aeschylus Sophocles and Euripides and their plays came to be presented as both the products and vital embodiments of an idealised Athenian past This study marks the first account of Athens' invention of its own theatrical heritage and sheds new light upon the interaction between

the city's literary and political history **The Siren and the Sage** Steven Shankman, Stephen Durrant, 2003-09-16 The cultures of ancient China and ancient Greece have exerted immeasurable influence on later civilizations The texts and cultural values of classical China spread throughout East Asia and became the foundation of learning in Korea Japan and Vietnam Greek learning and culture receive credit for many of the intellectual paradigms of the West Probably the one which is most distinctly Western is the tradition of logical proof and the related assumption that as Aristotle put it in *Metaphysics* 980 we all desire to know In contrast the Chinese tradition as exemplified by Laozi's *Dao de jing* cautions that through our desire to know we may forfeit wisdom thus engendering a split between knowledge and wisdom *The Siren and the Sage* is a comparative study of what some of the most influential writers of ancient China and ancient Greece thought it meant to know and whether they distinguished knowledge from wisdom It surveys selected works of poetry history and philosophy from roughly the eighth through the second centuries BCE focusing on the *Odyssey* the ancient Chinese *Classic of Poetry* Thucydides *History of the Peloponnesian War* Sima Qian's *Records of the Historian* Plato's *Symposium* Laozi's *Dao de jing* and the writings of Zhuangzi The intention through such juxtaposition is to introduce foundational texts of each tradition texts which continue to influence most of the world's peoples It is intriguing to ask what awareness if any these distinctive cultures had of each other A considerable body of scholarship comparing ancient Greece and ancient China now exists Scholars are presenting evidence that the two cultures may actually have been aware of each other's presence even though that awareness was presumably indirect perhaps mediated by the nomadic peoples of Central Asia While not directly contributing evidence the authors argue that comparing the cultures of Greece and China will continue to be an irresistible and important scholarly debate The book offers a provocative study which is accessible to students and general readers and at the same time contributes to the debate *Six Tragedies* Lucius Annaeus Seneca, 2010-01-14 This is a lively readable and accurate verse translation of the six best plays by one of the most influential of all classical Latin writers The volume includes *Phaedra* *Oedipus* *Medea* *Trojan Women* *Hercules Furens* and *Thyestes* together with an invaluable introduction and notes
