Comment la France a révolutionné le monde du vin Christophe Lucand, 2019-05-02 Printemps 1919 Il y a un siècle La France sort peine d'une guerre d'extermination qui a profondément bouleversé le pays sa population ruinée son économie et durablement affecté ses valeurs Alors que le pays accueille Paris la grande conférence de la Paix qui doit asseoir le nouvel ordre international le président de la République Raymond Poincaré promulgue une loi aussi inattendue qu'inattendue instaurant une reconfiguration complète des vignobles français Désormais c'est par une appellation d'origine que les producteurs pourront identifier leurs vins en revendiquant devant les tribunaux la délimitation géographique des vignes dont ils sont issus Cette loi du 6 mai 1919 constitue la matrice du paysage vitivinicole jusqu'à nos jours En rompant avec les dispositions libérales antérieures principalement basées sur les usages du commerce et de la marque elle donne naissance au modèle devenu par la suite triomphant des vins dits de terroir Surprenante et inattendue cette histoire est celle de l'émergence et de la promotion de la qualité du vin au fil d'un siècle d'histoire Elle est également celle d'une mise en ordre des vignobles français traversée une définition alors très novatrice et révolutionnaire des vins Un siècle plus tard ce retour inédit sur la genèse des vins d'appellations d'origine devenus vins de terroir nous offre les clefs de compréhension d'un système vitivinicole qui s'est depuis imposé toute l'Europe et a largement concouru au succès des vins français partout dans le monde *Histoire de la vigne et du vin en France des origines au XIXe siècle* Roger Dion, 1959 Le désir du vin. Jews and the Wine Trade in Medieval Europe Haym

Soloveitchik,2024-05-03 Although Jews were at the centre of commercial activity in medieval Europe a talmudic ban on any wine touched by a Gentile prevented them from engaging in the lucrative wine trade Wine was consumed in vast quantities in the Middle Ages and the banks of the Rhineland hosted some of the finest vineyards in northern Europe German Jews were until the thirteenth century a merchant class How could they abstain from trading in one of the region's major commodities In time they ruled that it was permissible to accept wine in payment of debt but forbade trading in it and they maintained that ban throughout the Middle Ages Further study in the twelfth century however led Talmudists to discover that Jews were only forbidden to profit from trading in Gentile wine if they dealt with idolaters but that trade with Christians and Muslims was permitted Nevertheless the German community refused to take advantage of this clear licence Using Jewish and Gentile sources this study probes the sources of this powerful taboo In describing the complex ways in which deeply held cultural values affect Jews engagement in the economy of the surrounding society this book also illustrates the law of unintended consequences how the ban on Gentile wine led both to a major Jewish contribution to German viticulture and to the involvement of Jews in moneylending with all its tragic consequences

State and Society in Eighteenth-Century

France Stephen Miller,2022-11-14 In contrast to the traditional Marxist interpretation of emerging capitalism and a revolutionary bourgeoisie this book shows that commodified labor fundamental to the existence of a capitalist bourgeoisie did not take shape in eighteenth century France The mass of the population consisted of peasants and artisans in possession of land and workshops and embedded in autonomous communities The old regime bourgeoisie and nobility thus developed within the absolutist state in order to have the political means to impose feudal forms of exploitation on the people These class relations explain the crisis of 1789 and the revolutionary conflicts of the 1790s

France Xavier de Planhol,Paul Claval,1994-03-17 In this 1994 book Xavier de Planhol and Paul Claval two of France's leading scholars in the field trace the historical geography of their country from its roots in the Roman province of Gaul to the 1990s They demonstrate how for centuries France was little more than an ideological concept despite its natural physical boundaries and long territorial history They examine the relatively late development of a more complex territorial geography

involving political religious cultural agricultural and industrial unities and diversities The conclusion reached is that only in the twentieth century had France achieved a profound territorial unity and only now are the fragmentations of the past being overwritten

Wine Drinking Culture in France Marion Demossier, 2010-07-15 This book provides a new interpretation of the relationship between consumption drinking culture memory and cultural identity in an age of rapid political and economic change Using France as a case study it explores the construction of a national drinking culture the myths symbols and practices surrounding it and then through a multisited ethnography of wine consumption demonstrates how that culture is in the process of being transformed Wine drinking culture in France has traditionally been a source of pride for the French and in an age of concerns about the dangers of binge drinking a major cause of jealousy for the British Wine drinking and the culture associated with it are for many an essential part of what it means to be French but they are also part of a national construction Described by some as a national product or as a totem drink wine and its attendant cultures supposedly characterise Frenchness in much the same way as being born in France fighting for liberty or speaking French Yet this traditional picture is now being challenged by economic social and political forces that have transformed consumption patterns and led to the fragmentation of wine drinking culture The aim of this book is to provide an original account of the various causes of the long term decline in alcohol consumption and of the emergence of a new wine drinking culture since the 1970s and to analyse its relationship to national and regional identity
