The story contains fictional elements. The goal is to bring history to life.

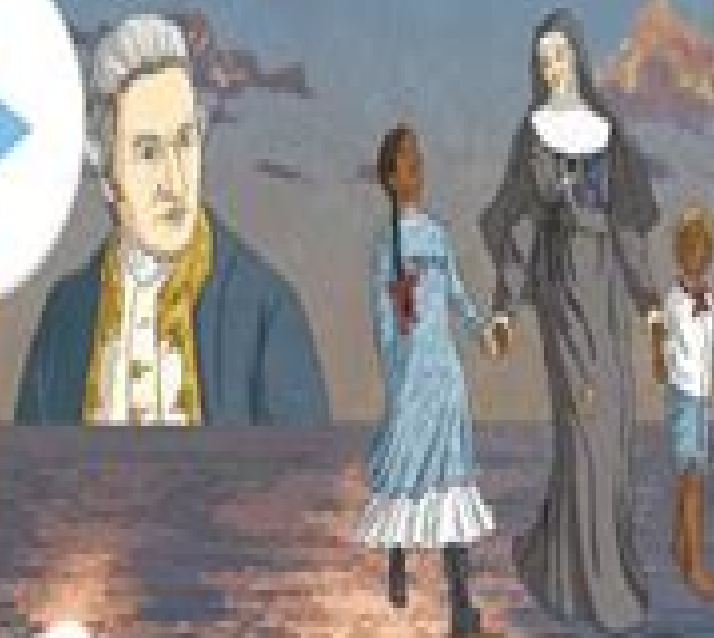
What Is Historical Fiction?

Nationalism and Historical Loss in Renaissance England Andrew Escobedo,2018-07-05 Andrew Escobedo here seeks to provide a new understanding of the emergence of national consciousness in England showing that many Renaissance writers articulated their Englishness temporally through an engagement with a history they perceived as lost or alienated According to Escobedo the English experienced nationalism as a form of community that disrupted earlier religious and social identities making it difficult to link the national present to the medieval past Furthermore he argues the English faced the nation s temporal isolation before the Enlightenment narrative of historical progress emerged as a means to interpret novelty in a positive light Escobedo examines how John Foxe John Dee Edmund Spenser and John Milton used narrative representations of nationhood to mediate what they perceived as a troubling breach in history attempting to bring together the English past present and near future in a complete and continuous story Yet all four authors also register their concern that historical loss may be an inevitable feature of a modern England and they come to see their narratives as long tapestries that spontaneously rip apart as they grow obliging the weaver to return to repair them Focusing on Renaissance England s perplexing sense of its time boundedness Escobedo presents early national consciousness as stranded awkwardly between the premodern and modern *Lying, Truthtelling, and Storytelling in Children's and Young Adult Literature* Anita Tarr,2023-12-20 Even though we instruct our children not to lie the truth is that lying is a fundamental part of children s development socially cognitively emotionally morally Lying can sometimes be more compassionate than telling the truth even more ethical Reading specific children s books can instruct child readers how to be guided by an etiquette of lying to know when to tell the truth and when to lie Equally important these stories can help prevent them from being prey to those liars who are intent on taking advantage of them Becoming a critical reader requires that one learn how to lie judiciously as well as to see through others lies When humans first began to speak we began to lie When we began to lie we started telling stories This is the paradox that in order to tell truthful stories we must be good liars Novels about child artists showcased here illustrate how the protagonist embraces this paradox accepting the stigma that a writer is a liar who tells the truth Emily Dickinson s phrase tell it slant best expresses the vision of how writers for children and young adults negotiate the conundrum of both protecting child readers and teaching them to protect

themselves This volume explores the pervasiveness of lying as well as the necessity for lying in our society the origins of lying as connected to language acquisition the realization that storytelling is both lying and truth-telling and the negotiations child artists must process in order to grasp the paradox that to become storytellers they must become expert liars and lie detectors
