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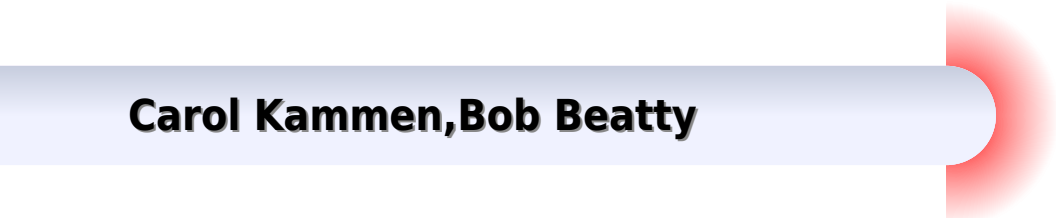

History and Material Culture Karen Harvey, 2017-09-18 Sources are the raw material of History but whereas the written word has traditionally been seen as the principal source historians now recognize the value of sources beyond text In this new edition of History and Material Culture contributors consider a range of objects from an eighteenth century bed curtain to a twenty first century shopping trolley which can help historians develop new interpretations and new knowledge about the past Containing two new chapters on healing objects in East Africa and the shopping trolley in the social world this book examines a variety of material sources from around the globe and across centuries to assess how such sources can be used to study the distant and the recent past In a revised introduction Karen Harvey discusses some of the principal issues raised when historians use material culture particularly in the context of the material turn and suggests some initial steps for those unfamiliar with these kinds of sources While the sources are discussed from interdisciplinary perspectives the emphasis of the book is on what historians stand to gain from using material culture as well as what historians have to offer the broader study of material culture Clearly written and accessible this book is the ideal introduction to the opportunities and challenges of researching material culture and is essential reading for all students of historical theory and method

Selling Women's History Emily Westkaemper, 2017-01-09 Only in recent decades has the American academic profession taken women s history seriously But the very concept of women s history has a much longer past one that s intimately entwined with the development of American advertising and consumer culture *Selling Women s History* reveals how from the 1900s to the 1970s popular culture helped teach Americans about the accomplishments of their foremothers promoting an awareness of women s wide ranging capabilities On one hand Emily Westkaemper examines how this was a marketing ploy as Madison Avenue co opted women s history to sell everything from Betsy Ross Red lipstick to Virginia Slims cigarettes But she also shows how pioneering adwomen and female historians used consumer culture to publicize histories that were ignored elsewhere Their feminist work challenged sexist assumptions about women s subordinate roles Assessing a dazzling array of media including soap operas advertisements films magazines calendars and greeting cards *Selling Women s History* offers a new perspective on how early and mid twentieth century women saw themselves Rather than presuming a drought of female agency between the first and second waves of American feminism it reveals the subtle messages about women s empowerment that flooded the marketplace

Frontiers of History Donald R. Kelley, 2006-01-01 In 1764 65 the irrepressible playwright Beaumarchais travelled to Madrid where he immersed himself in the life and society of the day Inspired by the places he had seen and the people he had met Beaumarchais returned home to

create *The Barber of Seville* and *The Marriage of Figaro* plays that became the basis for the operas by Rossini and Mozart that continue to delight audiences today This book is a lively and original account of Beaumarchais's visit to Madrid he never went to Seville and a re-creation of the society that fired his imagination Drawing on Beaumarchais's letters and commentaries translated into English for the first time Hugh Thomas investigates the full range of the playwright's activities in Madrid He focuses particular attention on short plays that Beaumarchais attended and by which he was probably influenced and he probes the inspirations for such widely recognized characters as the barber valet Figaro the lordly Count Almaviva and the beautiful but deceived Rosine Not neglecting Beaumarchais's many other pursuits ranging from an endeavour to gain a contract for selling African slaves to an attempt to place his mistress as a spy in the bed of King Charles III Lord Thomas provides a highly entertaining view of a vital moment in Madrid's history and in the creative life of the energetic Beaumarchais

s Committee of Seven and the first woman to be elected to its Executive Council An advocate of the new social history Salmon s teaching methods were novel at the time and continue to be relevant today Indeed Salmon advised students to go to the sources

Nabokov, History and the Texture of Time Will Norman,2012 This book argues that the apparent evasion of history in Vladimir Nabokov s fiction conceals a profound engagement with social and therefore political temporalities While Nabokov scholarship has long assumed the same position as Nabokov himself that his works exist in a state of historical exceptionalism this study restores the content context and commentary to Nabokovian time by reading his American work alongside the violent upheavals of twentieth century ideological conflicts in Europe and the United States This approach explores how the author s characteristic temporal manipulations and distortions function as a defensive dialectic against history an attempt to salvage fiction for autonomous aesthetics Tracing Nabokov s understanding of the relationship between history and aesthetics from nineteenth century Russia through European modernism to the postwar American academy the book offers detailed contextualized readings of Nabokov s major writings exploring the

Selling Empire Jonathan Eacott, 2016-02-02

Linking four continents over three centuries, *Selling Empire* demonstrates the centrality of India both as an idea and a place to the making of a global British imperial system. In the seventeenth century, Britain was economically, politically and militarily weaker than India, but Britons increasingly made use of India's strengths to build their own empire in both America and Asia. Early English colonial promoters first envisioned America as a potential India, hoping that the nascent Atlantic colonies could produce Asian raw materials. When this vision failed to materialize, Britain's circulation of Indian manufactured goods, from umbrellas to cottons to Africa, Europe and America then established an empire of goods and the supposed good of empire. Eacott recasts the British empire's chronology and geography by situating the development of consumer culture, the American Revolution and British industrialization in the commercial intersections linking the Atlantic and Indian Oceans. From the seventeenth into the nineteenth century and beyond, the evolving networks, ideas and fashions that bound India, Britain and America shaped persisting global structures of economic and cultural interdependence.

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
