Gopal and the Cowherd Anant Pai, 1979 *Gopal and the cowherd* GAYATRI MADAN DUTT, 1971-04-01 This simple Bengali folktale illustrating the power of faith was passed down from teacher to disciple from Sri Ramakrishna to Swami Vivekananda and from him to Sister Nivedita who recounted it in *Cradle Tales of Hinduism* Little Gopal is afraid to walk alone through the forest to school His mother tells him Call out to your cowherd brother He will come and protect you When Gopal calls out to his delight a cowherd with dancing eyes appears and escorts him to school **Gopal And The Cowherd** Editor: Anant Pai Author: Gayatri Madan Dutt Illustrator: Dilip Kadam, Gopal the son of a poor widow had to go to school passing through a forest of which he was afraid His mother told him to call for brother lord Krishna Gopal's fear was gone His teacher was also convinced of the appearance of brother at Gopal's call Anant Pai: Master Storyteller (Amar Chitra Katha) Anant Pai, 2008-11-07 Anant Pai strode the Indian comics industry like a colossus Using the comics format he told stories from mythology history and literature to generations of children Uncle Pai as he was known wanted Indian children to be familiar with their heritage He believed that it helped build self esteem and confidence He also wanted to bring the children of this country together through stories A chemical engineer by profession Anant Pai gave up his job to follow his dream a dream that led to the creation of Amar Chitra Katha and Tinkle Amar Chitra Katha pays tribute to its creator and traces the story of the man who left behind a legacy of learning and laughter *Dasharatha: Amar Chitra Katha* Amar Chitra Katha, **Rama** ANANT PAI, 1971-04-01 Rama was happy living in the forest with his wife and brother Palace intrigue may have forced his exile but the next fourteen years promised to be quite pleasant Suddenly this idyllic life was thrown into turmoil His beloved wife Sita was kidnapped With unmatched skill as a warrior Rama destroyed the ten headed Ravana And along the way he won a host of very grateful friends **Babur** TONI PATEL, 1971-04-01 Descended from the house of Timur and Genghis Khan Zahir ud din Muhammad Babur founded the Mughal dynasty in India Babur lived for most of his early life as an exile in and around his homeland in Central Asia Declared ruler of Farghana at the age of 12 the young boy had to contend with treacherous uncles tyrant neighbours and rebellious generals But he dealt with all of them even while moving towards his historic tryst with India *Durgadas* RAMESH SINHA, 1971-04-01 The life of Durgadas was one of the most extraordinary in the history of Rajasthan Women of Marwar were often blessed with the words May you have a son like Durgadas Durgadas staked his all to preserve the throne of Jodhpur after the death of King Jaswant Singh Durgadas was a model Rajput as wise as he was brave and a saviour of his land Raj Singh DEBRANI MITRA, 1971-04-01 The last independent warrior of Mewar Maharana Raj Singh ruled the kingdom during the reign of Aurangzeb the then Emperor of India When Chanchal Kumari the princess of Roopnagar flung a portrait of Aurangzeb and stepped on it Aurangzeb was furious by the news As a result he wanted to marry her as a mark of his insult Chanchal Kumari refused and requested Raj Singh to save her from the Mughal Emperor For a Rajput the honour of his womenfolk was of prime importance And the

events that follow this are an important and memorable part of history **The syamantaka gem** KAMALA CHANDRAKANT,1971-04-01 To the women of Dwarka Krishna is the most coveted jewel the husband they yearn for For most of the men the Syamantaka the sun god s shining gem is the most sought after prize This is hardly surprising it is known to regularly bestow a hoard of solid gold on their Prince Satrajit When the gem goes missing suspicion falls on Krishna He must prove his innocence but danger and upheaval threaten at every turn **Chaitanya Mahaprabhu** ANANT PAI,1971-04-01 Could a man of flesh and blood be lord Vishnu himself The infant who insisted on claiming the offerings made to the lord had matured into a single minded Vaishnava People thronged to him for his happy simple message of love This is the story of Chaitanya Mahaprabhu the renowned Vaishnava saint 16th century who popularized the chanting of the Hare Krishna mantra His followers regard him as an avatar of Krishna **The lord of lanka** ANANT PAI,1971-04-01 Ambition and arrogance these were to be the cause of Ravana s downfall Blessed by both Brahma the creator and Shiva the destroyer the powerful ruler of Lanka could have enjoyed fame and respect had he only reined in his arrogance It was left to Vishnu the preserver to find a way to curb Ravana In the process there unfolded one of the world s most beautiful romantic sagas the story of Rama s love for his devoted Sita **Prince Jivaka** GAYATRI MADAN DUTT,1971-04-01 In the kingdom of Hemangada a treacherous minister named Kattiyangaran decides to usurp the throne and kill the entire royal family Queen Vijaya escapes the slaughter In a dark cremation ground unhappy and alone she gives birth to a child and puts his father s royal ring upon his finger The child grows up to be Prince Jivaka Jivaka has many adventures but the core of the book becomes apparent in the end when a weary Jivaka decides to renounce his kingdom and become a Jain monk *Krishna and Narakasura* KAMALA CHANDRAKANT,1971-04-01 Indra was at his wit s end the impertinent demon Narakasura had stolen his mother s earrings Lord Krishna always helpful agreed to confront the enemy But seated on Garuda his trusty eagle and accompanied by the gentle Satyabhama would Krishna be able to overcome Narakasura s formidable defences Would his gleaming disc ever find its mark This is the story of why the first of four days of Diwali the Festival of Lights is named after Naraka **Samvarnana and tapati** GAYATRI MADAN DUTT,1971-04-01 Tapati the daughter of Surya catches the site of the mortal Samvarana and falls in love with him She appears before him in the forest and he is so enchanted by her he swoons and falls on the ground Tapati and Samvarana had a son named Kuru the ancestors of the Pandavas and the Kauravas The field of Kurukshetra upon which the battle takes place is also named after Kuru *Kapala Kundala* DEBRANI MITRA,1971-04-01 Bankim Chandra Chatterji was only twenty eight years old when he wrote his second novel Kapala Kundala It is said that when Bankim Chandra lived in Kanthi on the coast of south west Bengal a kapalik a Tantric worshipper of Kali or Shiva frequently visited him The mystery surrounding the kapalik made a deep impression on Bankim He conceived the idea of writing a novel about a girl brought up by a kapalik in complete isolation from the civilised world The name Kapala Kundala was taken from the Sanskrit play Malati Madhava In the play kapala is the associate of the evil kapalik

Aghora Ghanta She is as heinous as her mentor Though our heroine was also brought up by an evil kapalik she is full of human affection and kindness **Jackal Stories** KAMALA CHANDRAKANT,1971-04-01 The jackal has a bad reputation in the animal world Devious selfish dishonest and boastful his aspirations are high but his talents few He seldom repays a favour Should such a creature be tolerated Only so long as he uses his cunning for the good of the community says the wisdom of these Jataka tales which were written as early as the period between 3rd century BC and 5th century AD
