Gibson, 2015-12-07 Often overlooked in historic studies of New Orleans the city's Hispanic and Latino populations have contributed significantly to its development Hispanic and Latino New Orleans offers the first scholarly study of these communities in the Crescent City This trailblazing volume not only explores the evolving role of Hispanics and Latinos in shaping the city's unique cultural identity but also reveals how their history informs the ongoing national debate about immigration As early as the eighteenth century the Spanish government used incentives of land and money to encourage Spaniards from other regions of the empire particularly the Canary Islands to settle in and around New Orleans Though immigration from Spain declined markedly in the wake of the Louisiana Purchase the city quickly became the gateway between the United States and the emerging independent republics of Latin America The burgeoning trade in coffee sugar and bananas attracted Cuban and Honduran immigrants to New Orleans while smaller communities of Hispanics and Latinos from countries such as Mexico Puerto Rico and Brazil also made their marks on the landscapes and neighborhoods of the city particularly in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina Combining accessible historical narrative interviews and maps that illustrate changing residential geographies Hispanic and Latino New Orleans is a landmark study of the political economic and cultural networks that produced these diverse communities in one of the country's most distinctive cities The Cambridge History of Latina/o American Literature John Morán González, Laura Lomas, 2018-02-22 The Cambridge History of Latina/o American Literature

Orleans and its suburbs Fouts also highlights how immigrants forged multiracial solidarities to foster inclusive change at the local level By connecting migration labor and food Rebuilding New Orleans centers human experiences to illustrate how immigrant and established communities of color resisted criminalization and racial capitalism to create a more just New Orleans

Badillo, 2006-06-19 Latin Americans make up the largest new immigrant population in the United States and Latino Catholics are the fastest growing sector of the Catholic Church in America In this book historian David A Badillo offers a history of Latino Catholicism in the United States by looking at its growth in San Antonio Chicago New York and Miami Focusing on twentieth century Latino urbanism Badillo contrasts broad historic commonalities of Catholic religious tradition with variations of Latino ethnicity in various locales He emphasizes the contours of day to day life as well as various aspects of institutional and lived Catholicism The story of Catholicism goes beyond clergy and laity it entails the entire urban experience of neighborhoods downtown power seekers archdiocesan movers and shakers and a range of organizations and associations linked to parishes Although parishes remain the key site for Latino efforts to build individual and cultural identities Badillo argues that one must consider simultaneously the triad of parish city and ethnicity to fully comprehend the influence of various Latino populations on both Catholicism and the urban environment in the United States By contrasting the development of three distinctive Latino communities the Mexican Americans Puerto Ricans and Cuban Americans Badillo challenges the popular concept of an overarching Latino experience and offers instead an integrative approach to understanding the scope depth and complexity of the Latino contribution to the character of America s urban landscapes
