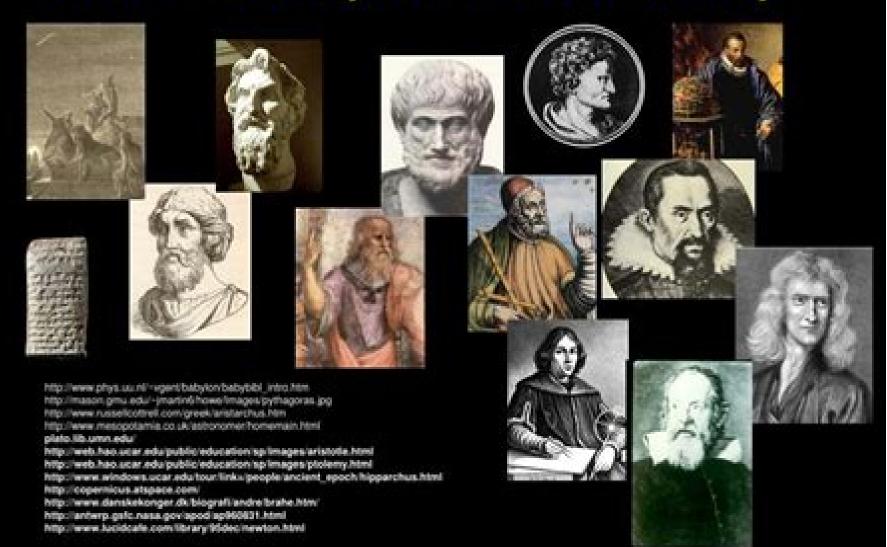

It seeks to know what the heavenly bodies are in themselves leaving the How and the Wherefore of their movements to be otherwise answered Now such inquiries became possible only through the invention of the telescope so that Galileo was in point of fact their originator But Herschel first gave them a prominence which the whole progress of science during the nineteenth century served to confirm
