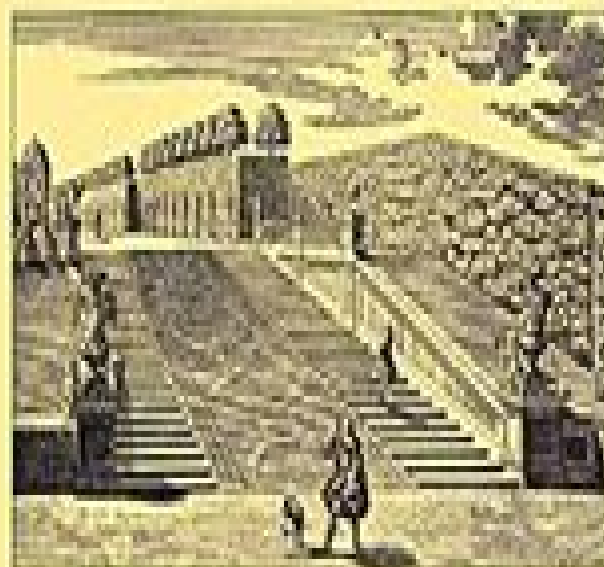
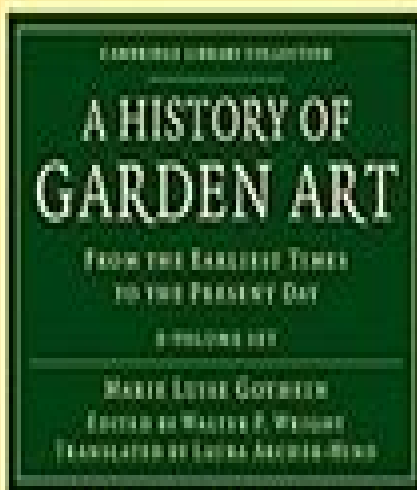

A History of Garden Art Marie Luise Schroeter Gothein, 2014 Marie Luise Gothein 1863-1931 published this scholarly two volume history of garden design in German in 1913. Its second edition of 1925 was translated into English by Laura Archer Hind edited by gardening author Walter P Wright 1864-1940 and published in 1928. The highly illustrated work is still regarded as among the most thorough and important surveys of its kind. It begins by examining evidence from both archaeology and literature as well as climate and soil conditions to discuss the gardens of ancient Egypt and Assyria and continues to survey developments worldwide until the twentieth century. Individual gardens technical innovations and fashions in horticulture are all discussed in detail. Volume 2 considers northern European gardens of the Renaissance the cultural importance of Louis XIV's France the impact of the introduction of foreign plants and gardening in Europe the Far East and North America up to the early twentieth century.

garden the shapes of land and water the established plants the light and wind the climate and show how these can be organized to give a place a special meaning And they pay particular attention to the rituals of habitation by which we imaginatively take possession of places on the surface of the earth The Poetics of Gardens examines great gardens made in other places with other climates at other times from ancient Rome to modern England from Ball to Botany Bay from the court of Ch'ien Lung to the magic kingdom of Walt Disney to explore their devices and record their images scents and sounds The authors discuss the adaptation of the great garden traditions of the past to North American soil and call together the creators of these gardens to speculate about how their patterns and ideas can be appropriated transformed and composed into places that come alive for us

The Language of Landscape Anne Whiston Spirn, 1998-01-01 This eloquent and powerful book combines poetry and pragmatism to teach the language of landscape Anne Whiston Spirn author of the award winning *The Granite Garden* *Urban Nature and Human Design* argues that the language of landscape exists with its own syntax grammar and metaphors and that we imperil ourselves by failing to learn to read and speak this language To understand the meanings of landscape our habitat is to see the world differently and to enable ourselves to avoid profound aesthetic and environmental mistakes Offering examples that range across thousands of years and five continents Spirn examines urban rural and natural landscapes She discusses the thought of renowned landscape authors Thomas Jefferson Frank Lloyd Wright Frederick Law Olmsted Lawrence Halprin and of less well known pioneers including Australian architect Glenn Murcutt and Danish landscape artist C. Documentation Eduard Kögel, 2015-07-31 Ernst Boerschmann was the most influential foreign architectural researcher in China in the first half of the twentieth century This book concerns his three year research expedition through the Chinese Empire 1906-1909 He was the first Westerner to systematically document China's religious architecture returning from his travels with thousands of photographs sketches and architectural surveys His six major publications leading up to 1931 described here alongside the reactions they caused were milestones on the path to formal study of Chinese architectural history long before Chinese academics themselves began to take interest in the subject in the 1930s
