The Complete Jacob Lawrence Peter Nesbett, Michelle DuBois, 2000-10-01 Born in 1917 Jacob Lawrence spent his childhood in New York City attending classes at the Harlem Community Art Center and the American Artists School and later working for the Federal Art Project While still in his twenties Lawrence exhibited his paintings at major museums across the country including the Phillips Collection the Metropolitan Museum of Art the Art Institute of Chicago and the Museum of Modern Art in New York where he became the first African American artist to have work represented in the permanent collection He lived painted and taught in New York City until 1971 when he joined the faculty of the University of Washington He is the recipient of numerous awards including the National Medal of Arts
