The exact theoretical techniques such as the T matrix method cannot be used for extremely large particles such as those in ice clouds because then the size parameter in the v index 2 a where a is the characteristic size radius for spheres and the associated numerical codes become unstable and produce wrong answers. Yet another problem is due to the fact that particles in many turbid media e.g. dust clouds cannot be characterized by a single shape. Often refractive indices also vary. Because of problems with theoretical calculations experimental laboratory investigations are important for the characterization and understanding of the optical properties of such types of particles.
