Comedy and the Woman Writer Judy Little,2015-08-01 Recent critics have affirmed the difficulty perhaps the impossibility of defining modern comedy at the same time some feminist scholars are seeking to understand the special comedy often present in literature written by women *Comedy and the Woman Writer* responds to both these concerns of recent criticism feminist literary theory and theories of comedy Judy Little develops a critical apparatus for identifying feminist comedy in recent fiction especially the radical political and psychological implications of this comedy and then applies and tests her theory by examining the novels of Virginia Woolf and Muriel Spark Despite recent scholarly attention to Woolf the profound comedy of her work has been largely overlooked and the comic fiction of Spark has seldom had the responsible and attentive criticism that it deserves The introductory chapter draws upon anthropology and sociology as well as literary criticism and the fiction of feminist writers such as Woolf Doris Lessing and Monique Wittig to define a modern feminist comedy Four central chapters then explore the implications of this comedy in the novels of Woolf and Spark Little distinguishes between on the one hand several varieties of traditional comedy and satire and on the other the festive or liminal comedy to which feminist comedy belongs Both Woolf and Spark mock centuries old mythic patterns and behaviors deriving from basic social norms as well as the values emerging from these norms It is one thing the author points out to find manners amusing to scourge vices or to mock the follies of lovers it is a much more drastic act of the imagination to mock the very norms against which comedy has traditionally judged vices follies and eccentricities While the comedy of Woolf and Spark has some precedent in festive or liminal celebrations during which even basic values and behavior are abandoned feminist comedy displays its radical nature by implying that there is no resolution to the inverted overturned world the world in revolutionary transition The final chapter considers briefly in the light of the critical model of feminist comedy the work of several other twentieth century writers including Jean Rhys Penelope Moritmer and Margaret Drabble The presence of

radical comedy in the fiction of these and other writers suggests the need for continuing attention to the theory of feminist comedy proposed in this study

Polygamy and Sublime Passion Keith McMahon, 2009-11-24 For centuries of Chinese history polygamy and prostitution were closely linked practices that legitimized the polygynous male the man with multiple sexual partners Despite their strict hierarchies these practices also addressed fundamental antagonisms in sexual relations in serious and constructive ways Qing fiction abounds in stories of female resistance and superiority Women main wives concubines and prostitutes were adept at exerting control and gaining status for themselves while men indulged in elaborate fantasies about female power In *Polygamy and Sublime Passion* Keith McMahon introduces a new concept passive polygamy to explain the unusual number of Qing stories in which women take charge of a man's desires turning him into an instrument of female will To this he adds a story that haunted the institutions of polygamy and prostitution the tale of sublime passion in which the main characters are a remarkable woman and her male lover Throughout the book McMahon examines how polygamy prostitution and the story of sublime passion encountered the first stages of paradigmatic change in the nineteenth century decades before the legal abolition of polygamy By the end of the Qing dynasty in 1911 love stories were celebrating the exploits of street smart prostitutes who fleeced gullible patrons in the bustling city of Shanghai What do these characters have in common with their early counterparts as men and women became inhabitants of a new city in an era flooded with ideas from radically foreign sources all of this taking place in a time of economic and cultural dislocation McMahon reads late Qing love stories in a historically symbolic way taking them as part of a larger fantasy of Chinese civilization undergoing a fundamental crisis The polygamous marriage and the affairs of the brothel became metaphorical staging grounds for portraying the destiny of China on the verge of modernity Finally McMahon speculates on the changes polygamous sexuality underwent after the Qing dynasty ended and whether it exerted a residual influence in later times *Polygamy and Sublime Passion* will undoubtedly engage those interested in Chinese society culture literature and gender studies as well as comparativists seeking to understand the diverse responses to modernization around the world
