Gullotta, 2020-05-11 In her Epilogue entitled What Is His Greatness Ola Elizabeth Winslow stated in the first serious modern biography of Jonathan Edwards In a word it is the greatness of one who had a determining art of initiating and directing a popular movement of far reaching consequence and who in addition laid the foundations for a new system of religious thought also of far reaching consequence After two and a half centuries since Edwards s death Winslow s statement is undoubtedly true and perhaps more so now than ever The recovery of Edwards pioneered by Perry Miller Ola Winslow and Thomas Schafer among others has become what is often referred to as an Edwards renaissance and has been made even more popular among lay people by John Piper Stephen Nichols and the like Since the free online access of The Works of Jonathan Edwards by Yale University dozens of books and articles as well as numerous dissertations each year are written to seek a facet of Edwards s greatness and thus as an exemplar of his continued far reaching consequence Jonathan Edwards more than any other pre revolutionary colonial thinker grappled with the promises and perils of the Enlightenment Organized by John T Lowe and Daniel N Gullotta Jonathan Edwards within the Enlightenment brings together a group of young and early career scholars to present their propping the life times and theology of one of America s greatest minds Many of these subjects have been seldom explored by scholars while others offer new and exciting avenues into well covered territory Some of these topics include Edwards interaction with and involvement in slavery colonialism racism as well as musings on gender populism violence pain and witchcraft

Barton Collection, 1888 **Performing Arts/books in Print**, 1973 **Afterlife** David Wyatt, 2025-05-22 Afterlife The Strange Fate of Literary Remains explores what happens to a body of work left unpublished or unfinished at the time of a writer's death In nine chapters David Wyatt tells the story of the afterlife of texts by Shakespeare William Wordsworth Charles Dickens Harriet Jacobs Emily Dickinson William Faulkner Sylvia Plath Ernest Hemingway and Ralph Ellison and of the improbable and unpredictable ways in which literature that might never have seen publication managed to end up on the printed page Posthumously edited texts raise important issues about the meaning and shape of a literary career How is one to assess the arc of Ellison's achievement when after his endlessly reworked second novel finally made it into print in 1999 it was then superseded in 2010 by another version Meanwhile the publication of four Hemingway books after the author's death undid any notion that the writer suffered some sort of decline late in life and the gender bending experiments in The Garden of Eden cast a revisionary light back on what had become a deeply reductive belief in the Hemingway Code While judgments about these writings may begin as technical matters Wyatt shows that they eventually become aesthetic and finally ethical considerations Despite the difficulties involved such evaluations continue to be made and to produce the editions that teachers and readers are required to choose among Throughout Afterlife Wyatt stresses the attentiveness needed in the editing of posthumous texts being mindful to honor an author's literary remains by providing an answerable reading of them while also caring enough about the work left behind to take a position on the printed form it might best take or if such a conclusion feels impossible to give a responsible account of why it is out of reach *Calendar* University of Manitoba, Winnipeg Manitoba. The One vs. the Many Alex Woloch, 2009-02-09 Does a novel focus on one life or many Alex Woloch uses this simple question to develop a powerful new theory of the realist novel based on how narratives distribute limited attention among a crowded field of characters His argument has important implications for both literary studies and narrative theory Characterization has long been a troubled and neglected problem within literary theory Through close readings of such novels as Pride and Prejudice Great

**Reading Architecture with Freud and Lacan** Lorens Holm,2022-09-30 Reading Architecture with Freud and Lacan Shadowing the Public Realm methodically outlines key concepts in psychoanalytic discourse by reading them against key modern and post modern architects It begins with what is arguably the central concept for each discipline by putting the unconscious in a dialectic relation to space Each subsequent chapter begins with a detail in architectural discourse a kind of provocation that anchors each excursion into the thought of Freud and Lacan The text is cyclical episodic and cloudlike rather than expository the intention is not simply to explain the concept of the unconscious but to different degrees perform it in the text The book offers powerful critiques of current planning practice which has no tools to address our attachment to places It concludes with powerful critiques of our incapacity to change the environmentally damaging ways we live our lives which is an effect of our incapacity to recognise the presence of the death drive in our nature The text is an extended thesis spanning the chapters that the field of the Other is the common grammar that organises subjects into civilisations which has consequences for how we treat the public realm in architecture politics and the city The field of the Other is a slightly different slice through the urban social world It shadows but does not correspond exactly to more familiar categories like private public inside outside figure ground or piazza boulevard Reading Architecture with Freud and Lacan will be an essential resource to anyone interested in how the environment we build is a reflection of our desire

Psychoanalysis is one of the great humanist discourses of the 20th century and this book will be a valuable reference to the humanist in architects planners and social scientists whether they are students professionals or amateurs It will appeal to historians of the 20th century and to psychoanalysts and architects who are interested in how their respective discourses interdigitate with each other and with other discourses

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
