
Baby Blue Whale

Then the calf takes in more air through its blowholes.

The whale calf starts to eat food when it is about six months old. Just like its mother, it eats tiny shrimp-like animals called krill. Blue whales have layers of baleen instead of teeth. Baleen is made of the same stuff as fingernails. It is like a big comb. The whale takes a huge gulp of ocean water. The baleen lets the water out, but not the krill.

Adult blue whales can be up to 100 feet long. That is about as long as three school buses! Adult blue whales are the largest animals in the world.
