between the depersonalized scientific account of death and the highly ritualized notion of death found in Tibetan Buddhism Thompson's depiction of death and dying offers an insightful neurobiological analysis while also delving into the phenomenology of death examining the psychological and spiritual effects of dying on human consciousness In a trenchant critique of the near death experience literature he shows that these experiences do not provide evidence for the continuation of consciousness after death but also that they must be understood phenomenologically and not in purely neuroscience terms We must learn to tolerate the ultimate ungraspability of death by bearing witness to dying and death instead of turning away from them We can learn to face the experience of dying through meditative practice and to view the final moments of life not as a frightening inevitability to be shunned or ignored but as a deeply personal experience to be accepted and even embraced
