One American's Story

Seventy miles south of Berlin, Joseph Polowsky and a patrol of American soldiers were scouting for signs of the Soviet army advancing from the east. As the soldiers neared the Elbe River, they saw lilacs in bloom. Polowsky later said the sight of the flowers filled them with joy.

Across the Elbe, the Americans spotted Soviet soldiers, who signaled for them to cross over. When the Americans reached the opposite bank, their joy turned to shock. They saw to their horror that the bank was covered with dead civilians, victims of bombing raids.

founded and led for seven decades by the four Starostin brothers the most visible of whom were Nikolai and Andrei Brilliant players turned skilled entrepreneurs they were flexible enough to constantly change their business model to accommodate the dramatic shifts in Soviet policy Whether because of their own financial wheeling and dealing or Spartak's too frequent success against state sponsored teams they were arrested in 1942 and spent twelve years in the gulag Instead of facing hard labor and likely death they were spared the harshness of their places of exile when they were asked by local camp commandants to coach the prisoners football teams Returning from the camps after Stalin's death they took back the reins of a club whose mystique as the people's team was only enhanced by its status as a victim of Stalinist tyranny Edelman covers the team from its days on the wild fields of prerevolutionary Russia through the post Soviet period Given its history it was hardly surprising that Spartak adjusted quickly to the new capitalist world of postsocialist Russia going on to win the championship of the Russian Premier League nine times the Russian Cup three times and the CIS Commonwealth of Independent States Cup six times In addition to providing a fresh and authoritative history of Soviet society as seen through its obsession with the world's most popular sport Edelman a well known sports commentator also provides biographies of Spartak's leading players over the course of a century and riveting play by play accounts of Spartak's most important matches including such highlights as the day in 1989 when Spartak last won the Soviet Elite League on a Valery Shmarov free kick at the ninety second minute Throughout he palpably evokes what it was like to cheer for the Red and White

Regalado, 2015-07-16 Faster than a speeding bullet More powerful than a locomotive Able to leap tall buildings in a single bound It s Superman Bending Steel examines the historical origins and cultural significance of Superman and his fellow American crusaders Cultural historian Aldo J Regalado asserts that the superhero seems a direct response to modernity often fighting the interrelated processes of industrialization urbanization immigration and capitalism that transformed the United States from the early nineteenth century to the present Reeling from these exciting but rapid and destabilizing forces Americans turned to heroic fiction as a means of explaining national and personal identities to themselves and to the world In so doing they created characters and stories that sometimes affirmed but other times subverted conventional notions of race class gender and nationalism The cultural conversation articulated through the nation s early heroic fiction eventually led to a new heroic type the brightly clad super powered pro social action heroes that first appeared in American comic books starting in the late 1930s Although indelibly shaped by the Great Depression and World War II sensibilities of the second generation immigrants most responsible for their creation comic book superheroes remain a mainstay of American popular culture Tracing superhero fiction all the way back to the nineteenth century Regalado firmly bases his analysis of dime novels pulp fiction and comics in historical biographical and reader response sources He explores the roles played by creators producers and consumers in crafting superhero fiction ultimately concluding that these narratives are essential for understanding vital trajectories in American culture

Ground Combat Ben Connable, 2025 Ground Combat reveals the gritty details of land warfare at the tactical level and challenges the overly subjective and often inaccurate American approach to characterizing war Ben Connable s motivation for writing the book is to replace overly subjective analyses with an evidence based approach to examining war From analyzing a set of over 400 global ground combat cases Connable shows there has been a modest and evolutionary shift in the characteristics of ground combat from World War II through the early 2020s This evidence of gradual change repudiates the popular but often hyperbolic arguments about military technical revolutions and that there is a singular character of war in the modern era Connable identifies past and current weaknesses in military design and strategy examines common characteristics in modern ground combat from the data and reframes the debate over the

historical and prospective impact of emerging technologies on war Ground Combat sets an evidentiary baseline and a new detail oriented standard for conflict research and policymaking

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
