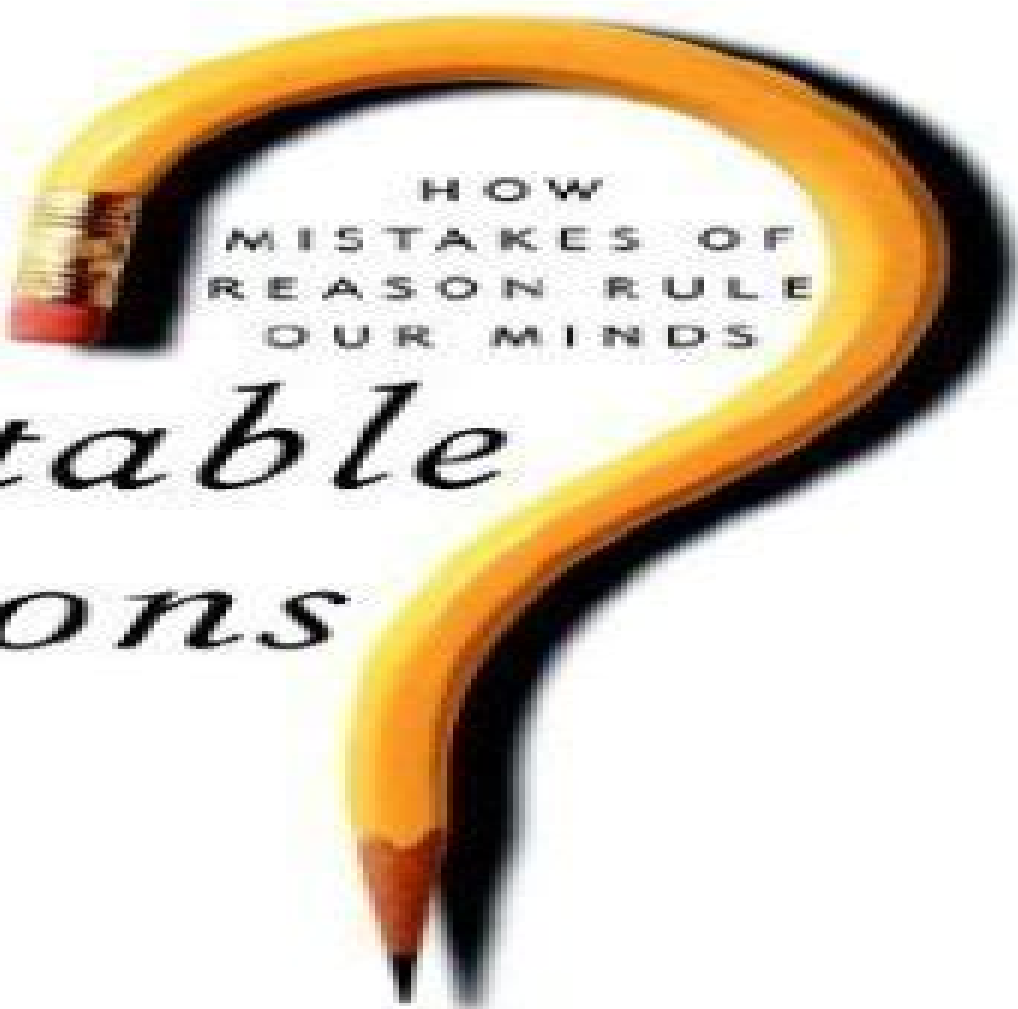

Judging Science Kenneth R. Foster, Peter W. Huber, 1999 Attempting to reconcile the law's need for workable rules of evidence with the views of scientific validity and reliability What is scientific knowledge and when is it reliable These deceptively simple questions have been the source of endless controversy In 1993 the Supreme Court handed down a landmark ruling on the use of scientific evidence in federal courts Federal judges may admit expert scientific evidence only if it merits the label scientific knowledge The testimony must be scientifically reliable and valid This book is organized around the criteria set out in the 1993 ruling Following a general overview the authors look at issues of fit whether a plausible theory relates specific facts to the larger factual issues in contention philosophical concepts such as the falsifiability of scientific claims scientific error reliability in science particularly in fields such as epidemiology and toxicology the meaning of scientific validity peer review and the problem of boundary setting and the risks of confusion and prejudice when presenting science to a jury The book's conclusion attempts to reconcile the law's need for workable rules of evidence with the views of scientific validity and reliability that emerge from science and other disciplines

Thinking about Evolution Rama S. Singh, 2001 Originally published in 2001 this is the second of two volumes published by Cambridge University Press in honour of Richard Lewontin This second volume of essays honours the philosophical historical and political dimensions of his work It is fitting that the volume covers such a wide range of perspectives on modern biology given the range of Lewontin's own contributions He is not just a very successful practitioner of evolutionary genetics but a rigorous critic of the practices of genetics and evolutionary biology and an articulate analyst of the social political and economic contexts and consequences of genetic and evolutionary research The volume begins with an essay by Lewontin on Natural History and Formalism in Evolutionary Genetics and includes contributions by former students post docs colleagues and collaborators which cover issues ranging from the history and conceptual foundations of evolutionary biology and genetics to the implications of human genetic diversity

Stanovich,1999-04-01 Integrating a decade long program of empirical research with current cognitive theory this book demonstrates that psychological research has profound implications for current debates about what it means to be rational The author brings new evidence to bear on these issues by demonstrating that patterns of individual differences largely ignored in disputes about human rationality have strong implications for explanations of the gap between normative and descriptive models of human behavior Separate chapters show how patterns of individual differences have implications for all of the major critiques of purported demonstrations of human irrationality in the heuristics and biases literature In these critiques it has been posited that experimenters have observed performance errors rather than systematically irrational responses the tasks have required computational operations that exceed human cognitive capacity experimenters have applied the wrong normative model to the task and participants have misinterpreted the tasks In a comprehensive set of studies Stanovich demonstrates that gaps between normative and descriptive models of performance on some tasks can be accounted for by positing these alternative explanations but that not all discrepancies from normative models can be so explained Individual differences in rational thought can in part be predicted by psychological dispositions that are interpreted as characteristic biases in people s intentional level psychologies Presenting the most comprehensive examination of individual differences in the heuristics and biases literature that has yet been published experiments and theoretical insights in this volume contextualize the heuristics and biases literature exemplified in the work of various investigators Current Legal Problems 1998 M.
