architecture in Central and Eastern Europe and it was this material that enabled their rebuilding after World War II and modernization during the following decades The authors search for the value of modernist architecture and using case studies from Poland Bulgaria Northern Macedonia Lithuania and Slovenia verify to what extent this heritage is embedded in the local socio economic milieu and becomes a basis for creating new values.
