short period of time Dr King nominated Thich Nhat Hanh for the Nobel Peace Prize in 1967 He wrote Thich Nhat Hanh is a holy man for he is humble and devout He is a scholar of immense intellectual capacity His ideas for peace if applied would build a monument to ecumenism to world brotherhood to humanity The two men bonded over a vision of the Beloved Community a vision described recently by Congressman John Lewis as a nation and world society at peace with itself It was a concept each knew of because of their membership within the Fellowship of Reconciliation an international peace organization and that Martin Luther King Jr had been popularizing through his work for some time Thich Nhat Hanh Andrus shows took the lineage of the Beloved Community from King and carried it on after his death Love's Rite R.
