Logic, on this account, depends on aspects of God's mind other than God's will. This is a nonstandard form of theistic logical dependence. It contrasts both with the standard form of theistic logical dependence according to which logic depends on God's will and with theistic logical independence according to which logic is independent of God. These rival views can be seen as the horns of the Logipphro dilemma: either logic depends on God's will, in which case special revelation would no longer be communicable, or logic is independent of God, in which case core claims of classical theism, for example, that God is the only independent being, would be violated. The best way to escape both of these horns, according to McGlothlin, is to adopt the nonstandard form of theistic logical dependence.
