Mahler Re-Composed George M. Cummins III, 2011-02-28 In 2010 the composer Gustav Mahler celebrates his one hundred fiftieth birthday In *Mahler Re-Composed* linguist George Cummins shares a collection of six interrelated essays that provide a fresh perspective on difficult questions familiar to Mahler lovers Cummins a teacher of Russian and Czech at Tulane University brings a uniquely Czech perspective to the study of Mahlers personality and work In his careful examination of the composers life and work Cummins begins with an introduction that provides a glimpse into Mahler the Czech and continues with an account of Mahlers conversion from Judaism to Catholicism while making his way to the Vienna Hofoper directorship Cummins also takes a skeptical look at the legend of Mahler as an impotent humorless neurotic and recreates the friendship between Strauss and Mahler two of the greatest musicians of the early twentieth century

Music in Vienna 1700, 1800, 1900 David Wyn Jones, 2016 Focussing on three different epochs 1700 1800 and 1900 this book explores the history of music in Vienna allowing the very different relationships between music and society that existed in each of these periods to be distinguished

Gustav Mahler Alfred Mathis-Rosenzweig, 2018-05-08 Alfred Mathis Rosenzweig 1897 1948 was a Viennese musicologist and critic who studied at the universities of Budapest and Vienna From 1933 he embarked on producing a large scale study of Mahler but at the time of his death the manuscript was left unfinished Although it was presumed lost until 1997 the unfinished typescript written in German had been deposited in the library of the Guildhall School of Music Drama In 2003 the School s Research Centre commissioned Jeremy Barham to prepare the first published edition of this important work and his annotations and commentary add invaluable material to his translation of this historic document Biographical material is used as a loose framework and platform for Mathis Rosenzweig s profound examination of the environment within which Mahler s earlier music was embedded This is an environment in which Wagner Bruckner and Wolf feature prominently and in which Mahler s music is viewed from the wider perspective of nineteenth century German cultural domination and the subsequent rise of political extremism in the form of Hitlerite fascism

The Creative Process in Music from Mozart to Kurtág William Kinderman, 2012-10-18 In this intriguing study William Kinderman opens the door to the composer s workshop investigating not just the final outcome but the process of creative endeavour in music Focusing on the stages of composition Kinderman maintains that the most rigorous basis for the study of artistic creativity comes not from anecdotal or autobiographical reports but from original handwritten sketches drafts revised manuscripts and corrected proof sheets He explores works of major composers from the eighteenth century to

the present from Mozart's piano music and Beethoven's Piano Trio in F to Kurtág's Kafka Fragments and Hommage à R. Sch. Other chapters examine Robert Schumann's Fantasia in C, Mahler's Fifth Symphony and Bartók's Dance Suite. Hidden Treasures Molly M. Breckling, 2023-04-16 Gustav Mahler once said, "With song you can express so much more in the music than the words directly say." The text is actually a mere indication of the hidden treasure within. Over fourteen years from 1887-1901, he devoted his compositional output almost exclusively to texts and ideas drawn from a collection of German folk poetry entitled *Des Knaben Wunderhorn* (Alte deutsche Lieder), resulting in twenty-four songs which heavily inspired his first four symphonies. This study explores Mahler's songs based on this poetry and identifies the connections the composer found between these products of Germany's folk past and his own contemporary environment. The songs he created comment on and engage with Vienna's musical life, Freudian theory, Mahler's religious life, his family relationships, his views on women and romance, economic inequality, and wartime violence. As remnants of a folk tradition, the poems contained in *Des Knaben Wunderhorn* served the purpose of instructing young people on ways of conducting themselves, just as fairy tales do today. Mahler's adaptation of these stories and his updating of them to serve audiences of his own time demonstrate the universality of the lessons these
