narrative history of the 1861 Washington Peace Conference the bipartisan last ditch effort to prevent the Civil War an effort that nearly averted the carnage that followed In February 1861 most of America's great statesmen including a former president dozens of current and former senators Supreme Court justices governors and congressmen came together at the historic Willard Hotel in a desperate attempt to stave off Civil War Seven southern states had already seceded and the conferees battled against time to craft a compromise to protect slavery and thus preserve the union and prevent war Participants included former President John Tyler General William Sherman's Catholic step father General Winfield Scott and Lincoln's future Treasury Secretary Salmon Chase and from a room upstairs at the hotel Lincoln himself Revelatory and definitive *The Peace That Almost Was* demonstrates that slavery was the main issue of the conference and thus of the war itself and that no matter the shared faith family and friendships of the participants ultimately no compromise could be reached
