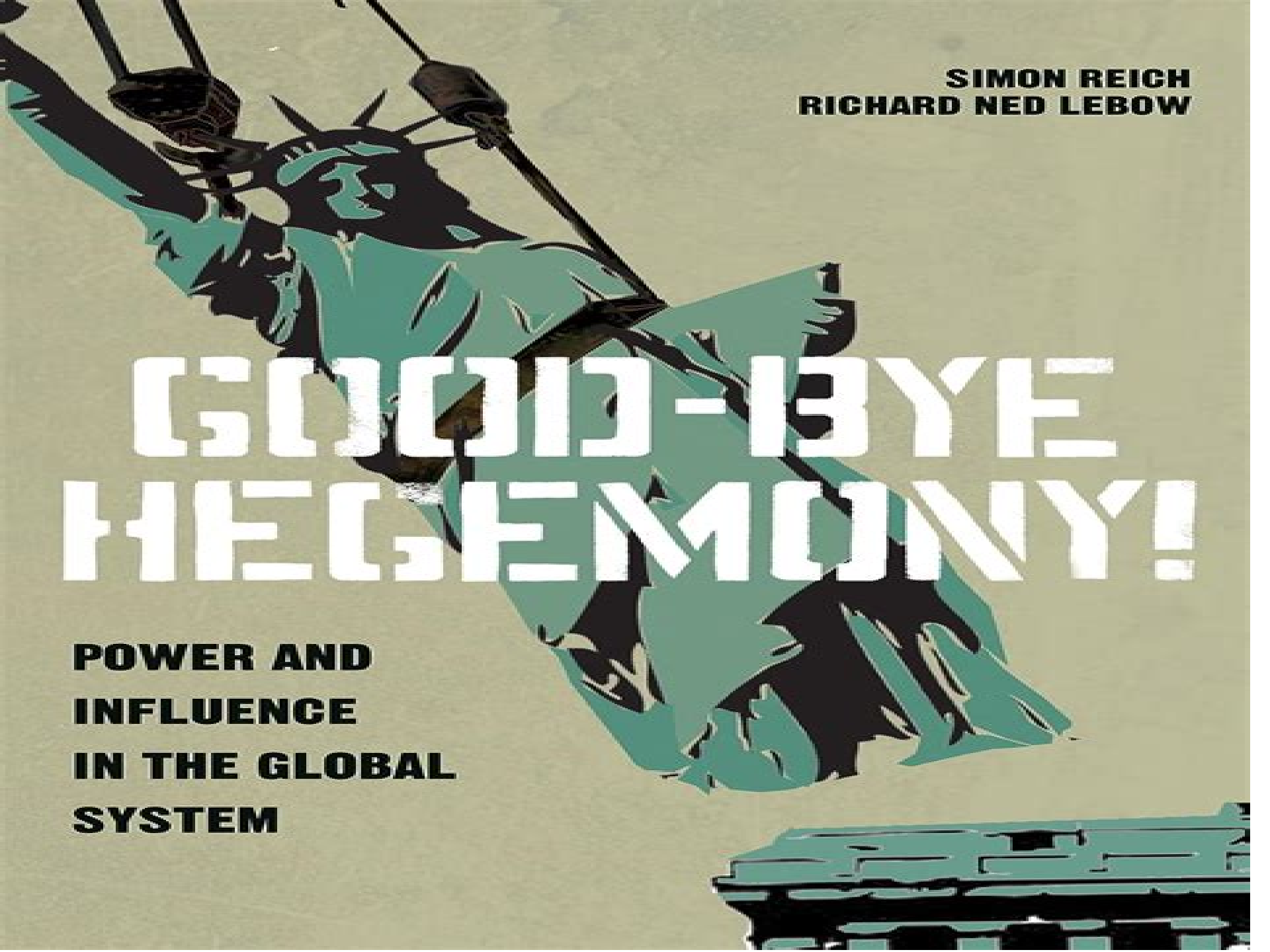




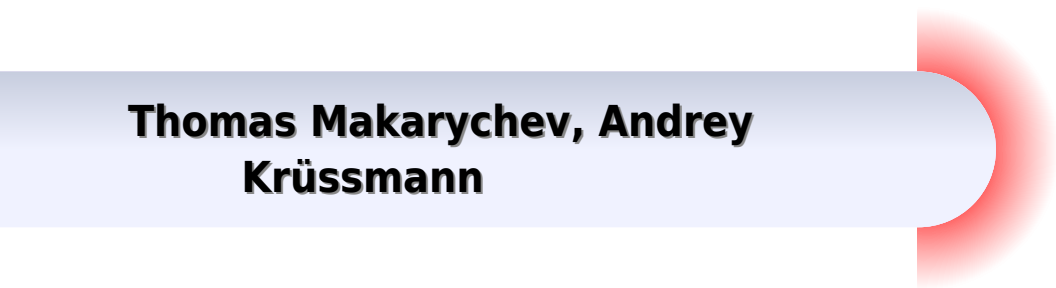

Good-Bye Hegemony! Simon Reich, Richard Ned Lebow, 2014-03-23 Many policymakers, journalists and scholars insist that U.S. hegemony is essential for warding off global chaos. Good Bye Hegemony argues that hegemony is a fiction propagated to support a large defense establishment, justify American claims to world leadership, and buttress the self-esteem of voters. It is also contrary to American interests and the global order. Simon Reich and Richard Ned Lebow argue that hegemony should instead find expression in agenda setting, economic custodianship, and the sponsorship of global initiatives. Today these functions are diffused through the system with European countries, China, and lesser powers making important contributions. In contrast, the United States has often been a source of political and economic instability. Rejecting the focus on power common to American realists and liberals, the authors offer a novel analysis of influence. In the process, they differentiate influence from power and power from material resources. Their analysis shows why the United States, the greatest power the world has ever seen, is increasingly incapable of translating its power into influence. Reich and Lebow use their analysis to formulate a more realistic place for America in world affairs. Norms Without the Great Powers Adam Bower, 2017-02-09 Can multilateral treaties succeed in transforming conduct when they are rejected by the most powerful states in the international system? In the past two decades, coalitions of middle power states and transnational civil society groups have negotiated binding legal agreements in the face of concerted opposition from China, Russia, and most especially, the United States. These instances of a so-called new diplomacy reflect a deliberate attempt to use the language of international law to bypass great power objections in establishing new global standards. Yet critics have frequently derided such treaties as utopian and counterproductive because they fail to include those states allegedly most capable of effectively managing complex international cooperation. Thus far, no study has offered a systematic comparative study of the promise and limits of multilateralism without the great powers. Norms Without the Great Powers addresses this gap through the presentation of a novel theoretical account and detailed empirical evidence regarding the implementation of two archetypal cases: the antipersonnel Mine Ban Treaty and the International Criminal Court. Both treaties have substantially reshaped expectations and behaviour in their respective domains, but with important variation in the extent and breadth of their impact. These findings provide the impetus for assessing the prospects for similar strategies on other topics of contemporary global concern. this book traces how each side's ideal self came into conflict with fault lines in international politics Russia's 2022 full scale invasion of Ukraine is not only a symptom of conflict taking over the European continent but also a point of no return that will be difficult to roll back Could the state of conflict on the European continent have been avoided To understand the nature and evolution of conflict with Russia this book presents a theoretically informed discussion of the way relations between the European Union EU and Russia deteriorated beyond repair during the more than three decades since the collapse of the Soviet Union First the book develops the concept of ideal self of states and international organisations like the EU which posits that a series of ideal perceptions about how the self should act in the world order drives the behaviour of states and their policymakers Second the book turns to the study of fault lines or spaces of divergence in the world order that harbour the potential for conflict With these two theoretical toolkits the book shows how leaders in the EU and Russia by February 2022 came to view conflict as a feasible preferable and possibly the only option available to them Even though neither the EU nor Russia had desired conflict both made little effort to avoid it As a result the European continent has sleepwalked into conflict with the potential for that conflict to spill over from Europe and escalate beyond a point of no return between the West and its global challengers

demonstrates that foreign policies consistent with generally accepted ethical norms are more likely to succeed and those at odds with them to fail Constructing original data sets and analyzing multiple case studies Lebow makes an empirical case for ethics in international relations His approach looks to create a productive dialogue between those who ask primarily ought questions and those who pose is questions The former want to establish appropriate criteria for the behaviour of state and non state actors and the discourses that lead to their policy decisions whereas scholars who pose is questions are concerned with how political actors behave and the principles and assumptions that might explain their behaviour Lebow bridges the gap between is and ought questions by making an instrumental argument in favour of ethical foreign policy He examines policymaking as well as policy offering ethical guidelines for policymaking that are likely to result in more successful policies
