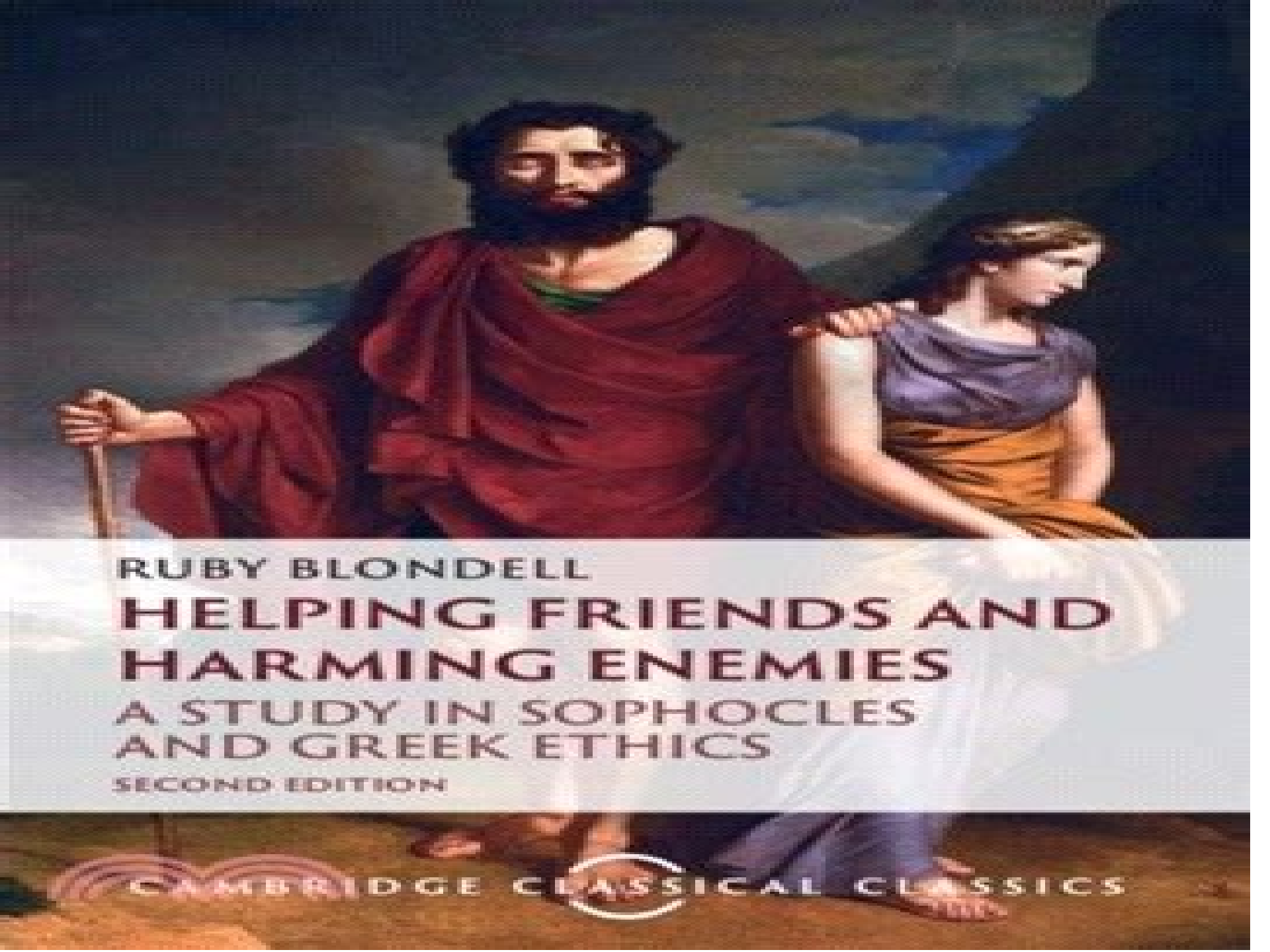

Zero to Hero, Hero to Zero Lydia Langerwerf, Cressida Ryan, 2020-05-15 Hercules is a hero we were all brought up to appreciate the basic idea of the ancient hero But what about him makes him one This book aims to challenge some of the standard expectations as to what constitutes a hero considering the phenomenon of heroism from a range of viewpoints In this book we invite you to walk around the monumental notions of the hero and heroism and endeavour to reach out and touch them on all sides The chapters in this volume testify to the difficulty of answering the question what is a hero and engage with a variety of themes in attempting to offer some replies They demonstrate not just the variety of ways in which the protagonists of ancient literature can be deemed heroic but also the tendency for aspects of heroism to turn sour once identified It seems that the moment we recognise heroic features we are forced to question them Do heroes necessitate anti heroes for example Portraying protagonists heroic qualities in an ambiguous light focuses the reader's attention on the problem of realising the ideals of heroism in historic actuality Various chapters ask the rhetorical question of whether we should expect or more importantly desire historical actors to behave like mythical heroes To what extent can a hero ever be integrated into normal society What difference might there be between a tragic and an epic hero The commonplace The only good hero is a dead hero summarises the extent to which this book also focuses on heroic death and dying Covering Euripides to Monty Python Roman soldiers to the modern military this volume offers the reader a chance to think about the changing notion of the hero and recognise heroic qualities throughout western culture

Whose Antigone? Tina Chanter, 2011-07-01 In this groundbreaking book Tina Chanter challenges the philosophical and psychoanalytic reception of Sophocles Antigone which has largely ignored the issue of slavery Drawing on textual and contextual evidence including historical sources she argues that slavery is a structuring theme of the Oedipal cycle but one that has been written out of the record Chanter focuses in particular on two appropriations of Antigone The Island set in apartheid South Africa and T g nni set in nineteenth century Nigeria Both plays are inspired by the figure of Antigone and yet they rework her significance in important ways that require us to return to Sophocles original play and attend to some of the motifs that have been marginalized Chanter explores the complex set of relations that define citizens as opposed to noncitizens free men versus slaves men versus women and Greeks versus barbarians Whose Antigone moves beyond the narrow confines critics have inherited from German idealism to reinvigorate debates over the meaning and significance of Antigone situating it within a wider argument that establishes the salience of slavery as a structuring theme
