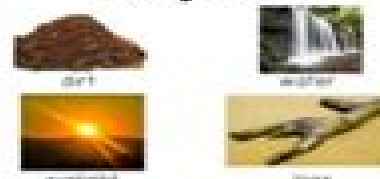

#### Living Things in an Ecosystem

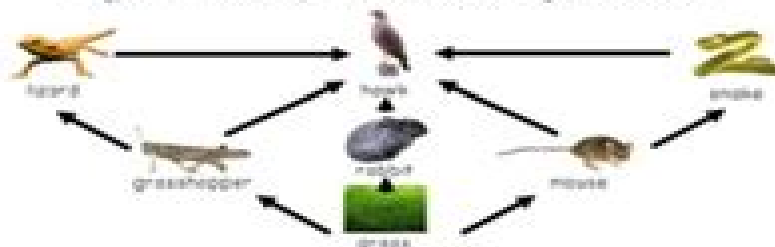


#### Nonliving Things in an Ecosystem

A **food web** shows all of the food chains in an ecosystem. The arrows show the flow of energy. Below is an example of a food web from a grassland habitat.

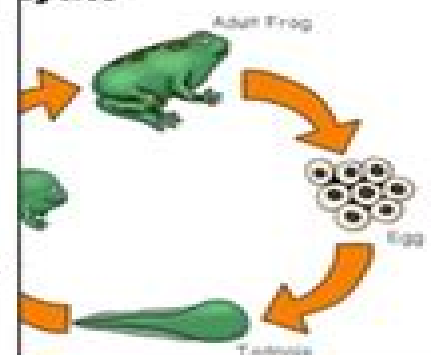
