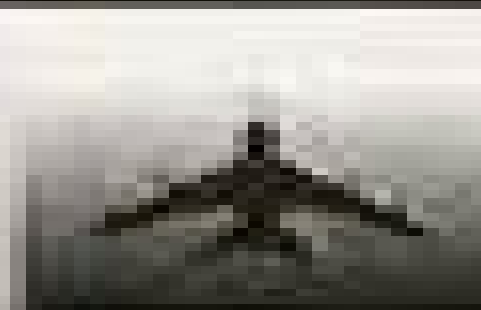

Midlarsky, 2000 Essays reflecting the most recent theoretically and empirically oriented research on international warfare *Causes and Consequences of International Conflict* Glenn Palmer, 2009-10-16 Investigation into the causes of international conflict has in many ways formed the central locus of the early work in the scientific investigation of world politics This edited volume contains the most recent quantitative work in this area reflecting the current state of the field in the topics addressed the data utilized and the methods employed The book is divided into three parts presenting first some recent contributions to the work on the causes of international conflict set in the context of realist theories The second part addresses issues relating to data methods and cases used to analyze international conflict while the third part presents some examples of the use of a variety of different methods to answer questions relating to issues which engage international relations scholars today The chapters focus on a variety of pertinent topics and include discussions of important innovations in our ability to analyze conflict such as the introduction of the Militarized Interstate Dispute MID data **North Korea, Nuclear Risk-Taking, and the United States** Jihwan Hwang, 2023-11-13 Jihwan Hwang analyzes Pyongyang's nuclear policy changes over the last three decades under Kim Il Sung Kim Jong Il and Kim Jong Un Why did a weaker North Korea take the risk of standing up against the much stronger U S with its nuclear weapons program even escalating the crisis to the point of a war Later why did North Korea change its course of action amid the crisis even though the security environment remained essentially the same Hwang draws on the main tenets of prospect theory in international relations and argues that Pyongyang becomes either risk acceptant or risk averse toward the U S depending on the situation it faces When Pyongyang perceived the status quo to be deteriorating it framed its situation as a loss and chose a risk acceptant of confrontation to restore the status quo Equally when Pyongyang perceived the situation to be improving it chose a risk averse engagement in the domain of gain In contrast when Pyongyang perceived an extreme loss such as military confrontation against the United States it would rather choose a risk averse policy to avoid the catastrophic outcome of war The issues of risk are central to an understanding of Pyongyang's nuclear policy decision making **Framing Terrorism** Pippa Norris, Montague Kern, Marion Just, 2004-08-02 Framing Terrorism argues that the September 11 attacks precipitated a critical shift in the predominant news frame used by the US mass media for understanding issues of national security thereby altering perceptions of risk at home and abroad **Forgotten Partnership Redux , Acting Alone** Bradley F. Podliska, 2010-03-16 Acting Alone A Scientific Study of American Hegemony and Unilateral Use of Force Decision Making is a straight forward analysis of unilateral U S military actions which are dependent upon the power disparity between the U S and the rest of the world In solving the puzzle as to why individual presidents have made the wrong decision to act alone the author lays out a president's behavior during a crisis as a two step decision process Acting Alone reviews the well studied first decision deciding to use force based on international conflict literature and organized along traditional lines

The author then details the second decision deciding to use unilateral force with an explanation of the criticisms of multilateralism and the reasons for unilateralism To test a new theory of unilateral use of force decision making Acting Alone devises a definition and coding rules for unilateral use of force develops a sequential model of presidential use of force decision making and constructs a new alternative measure of military power a Composite Indicator of Military Revolutions CIMR It then uses three methods a statistical test with a heckman probit model an experiment and case studies to test U S crisis behavior since 1937 By applying these three methods the author finds that presidents are realists and make expected utility calculations to act unilaterally or multilaterally after their decision to use force The unilateral decision in particular positively correlates with a wide military gap with an opponent an opponent located in the Western hemisphere and a national security threat

Reconceptualizing Deterrence Elli Lieberman,2013 This book offers a reconceptualisation of conventional deterrence theory and applies it to enduring rivalries in the Middle East The work argues that many of the problems encountered in the development of deterrence theory lay in the fact that it was developed during the Cold War when the immediate problem it had to address was how to prevent catastrophic nuclear wars The logic of nuclear deterrence compelled a preoccupation with the problem of stability over credibility however because the logic of conventional deterrence is different the solution of the tension between credibility and stability is achieved by deference to credibility due to the requirements of reputation and costly signaling This book aims to narrow the gap between theory and evidence It explores how a reconceptualization of the theory as a process that culminates in the internalization of deterrence within enduring rivalries is better suited to account for its final success a finding that has eluded deterrence theorists for long This interdisciplinary book will be of much interest to students of deterrence theory strategic studies international security Middle Eastern studies and IR in general

Nuclear Logics Etel Solingen, 2009-02-09 Nuclear Logics examines why some states seek nuclear weapons while others renounce them Looking closely at nine cases in East Asia and the Middle East Etel Solingen finds two distinct regional patterns In East Asia the norm since the late 1960s has been to forswear nuclear weapons and North Korea which makes no secret of its nuclear ambitions is the anomaly In the Middle East the opposite is the case with Iran Iraq Israel and Libya suspected of pursuing nuclear weapons capabilities with Egypt as the anomaly in recent decades Identifying the domestic conditions underlying these divergent paths Solingen argues that there are clear differences between states whose leaders advocate integration in the global economy and those that reject it Among the former are countries like South Korea Taiwan and Japan whose leaders have had stronger incentives to avoid the political economic and other costs of acquiring nuclear weapons The latter as in most cases in the Middle East have had stronger incentives to exploit nuclear weapons as tools in nationalist platforms geared to helping their leaders survive in power Solingen complements her bold argument with other logics explaining nuclear behavior including security dilemmas international norms and institutions and the role of democracy and authoritarianism Her account charts the most important frontier in understanding nuclear proliferation

grasping the relationship between internal and external political survival Nuclear Logics is a pioneering book that is certain to provide an invaluable resource for researchers teachers and practitioners while reframing the policy debate surrounding nonproliferation
