First Aid Managing Bleeds

1.

Apply direct pressure: Use a clean cloth or gauze pad to apply pressure directly on the wound to help stop the bleeding.

2.

Elevate the wound: If possible, elevate the affected limb above the level of the heart to help reduce blood flow to the area.

3.

Use a tourniquet: In a last resort, if bleeding is severe and cannot be controlled by direct pressure or elevation, a tourniquet may be used as a last resort to stop blood flow to the affected area.

RECOGNIZING CARDIAC ARREST:

Signs to Look For

- Unresponsiveness: If the person is not responding when you try to wake them up, they may be in cardiac arrest.
- Absence of breathing: Check if the person is breathing by looking for chest movements or listening for sounds of breathing. If there are none, it may indicate cardiac arrest.
- No pulse: Use for all ages including infants and patients with.



BASIC STEPS OF CPR

- Check the scene for safety and responsiveness of the victim.
- Call emergency services and retrieve an AED if available.
- Open the airway by tilting the head back and lifting the chin.
- Check for normal breathing or coughing/gagging. If absent, begin CPR.
- Start 30 chest compressions at a rate of 100-120 per minute.
- Open the airway and give 2 breaths, waiting for chest rise.
- Continue the cycle of compressions and breaths until emergency services arrive or the victim shows signs of movement/breathing.



Act FAST: 3 Steps for Stroke Management



Face:
Check for facial drooping or numbness.



Arms:
Check for arm weakness or numbness.



Speech:
Check for slurred speech or difficulty speaking.

CPR is as easy as C-A-B

• Compressions

Push hard and fast on the center of the victim's chest

• Airway

Tilt the victim's head back and lift the chin to open the airway

• Breathing

Give mouth-to-mouth rescue breaths

CPR matters because it can help save a person's life during a medical emergency. By circulating blood and oxygen throughout the body, CPR keeps vital organs alive until advanced medical care can be administered. It is a simple yet critical skill that can be performed by anyone, making it an essential tool in emergency situations. Without prompt CPR, the chances of survival decrease significantly, making it important to learn and perform the technique in case of an emergency.
