The Electoral College elects the president, When voters choose a condidate's name from the ballot, they are actually choosing a list of Electoral College members who elector to vote for that condidate.
- Analyzing How is it possible that the electoral votes of just a few small states can determine the outcome of a close presidential election?

West states have a winner-take-all system. If a condidate wins by

just a few popular votes in a state, that condidate wins all the state's

electoral votes. The condidate might win several small states by winner-take-all and gain enough electoral votes to win the national election.
