course of children's literature On the eve of World War I Edith's husband died and she married a captain of the Woolwich Ferry A cheerful cockney sparrow Tommy Tucker proved to be Edith's unwitting romantic hero who loved and cherished her until she died in near poverty on the Romney Marshes of Kent
