A smooth and safe mobility is only possible when the mobile person is well informed of the happenings in his ambient environments. Location sensitive maps have proved a strong enhancement to what a mobile user can directly perceive from his ambient environments. Since ancient times the map has been the favorite communication language of spatial information. It is even more the case for mobile applications where brand new maps can be wirelessly retrieved or generated in real time. The upsurge of map based services on mobile devices has raised a number of new questions challenging the conventional computer assisted cartography. Map based mobile services provides a contemporary overview of research and development issues related to the design and the use of mobility supporting maps. The book has been written for professional cartographers who are striving for tending their theoretical methodological and practical knowledge to mobile mapping for surveyors and geo service providers involved in the development of intelligent location based services for software developers and cognitive scientists engaged in human computer interaction and for students and academics in cartography and geoinformation sciences.
