## Preschool:

- Student will stand in an open space, without support, and independently balance on either foot momentarily.
- When verbally coed, <u>student</u> will jump in place four to six times consecutively, taking
  off from and landing on two feet with balance and control.
- 3. In a space free from obstacles, student will bop on either left or right foot one time.
- Using a 10° red rubber playground ball, <u>student</u> will walk up to the ball from a distance of 6' and kick the ball.
- From a standing position with balance, <u>student</u> will hold a tennis ball in preferred hand and throw it overhand for a distance of at least six feet.
- Using a 10" red rubber playground ball, student will stand 6' from instructor, and will
  use arms, chest, and body to catch the ball.
- Sitting on a tricycle with feet on the pedals, gradent will pedal the tricycle forward for a 10' distance.
- Standing in a clear space, <u>student</u> will independently stand on either left or right foot for 5 seconds with balance and control.
- Student will run in a straight running lane for a distance of 50 yards in less than 20 seconds.
