Gregory the Great and His World R. A. Markus, 1997-10-09 Markus's new and accessible work is the first full study of Gregory the Great since that of F. H. Gregory's culture is described in the context of the late Roman educational background and in the context of previous patristic tradition. Markus seeks to understand Gregory as a cultivated late Roman aristocrat converted to the ascetic ideal caught in the tension between his attraction to the monastic vocation and his episcopal ministry at a time of catastrophic change in the Roman world. The book deals with every aspect of his pontificate as bishop of Rome as landlord of the Church lands in his relations to the Empire and to the Western Germanic kingdoms in Spain, Gaul, and especially his mission to the English.

Holy Bishops in Late Antiquity Claudia Rapp, 2013-05-01 Between 300 and 600 Christianity experienced a momentous change from persecuted cult to state religion One of the consequences of this shift was the evolution of the role of the bishop as the highest Church official in his city from model Christian to model citizen Claudia Rapp's exceptionally learned innovative and groundbreaking work traces this transition with a twofold aim to deemphasize the reign of the emperor Constantine which has traditionally been regarded as a watershed in the development of the Church as an institution and to bring to the fore the continued importance of the religious underpinnings of the bishop's role as civic leader Rapp rejects Max Weber's categories of charismatic versus institutional authority that have traditionally been used to distinguish the nature of episcopal authority from that of the ascetic and holy man Instead she proposes a model of spiritual authority ascetic authority and pragmatic authority in which a bishop's visible asceticism is taken as evidence of his spiritual powers and at the same time provides the justification for his public role In clear and graceful prose Rapp provides a wholly fresh analysis of the changing dynamics of social mobility as played out in episcopal appointments
