46. If anyone owes a debt for a loan, and a storm overwhelms the grain (barley), or the harvest fails, or the owner does not grow for lack of water, in that year he need not give his creditor any grain, his creditor has forfeited his water and pays no rent for this year.

122. If a merchant entrusts money to an agent (broker) for some investment, and the broker suffers a loss in the process in which he gains, he shall make good the capital to the merchant.

123. If anyone fails to meet a claim for debt, and put himself, his wife, his son, and daughter for money or give them away to another man, they shall work for three years in the house of the man who bought them, or the proprietor, and in the fourth year they shall be set free.

124. If anyone give another silver, gold, or goods on loan,

1930 BC and the codex of Lipit Ishtar of Isin c 1870 BC while later ones include the Hittite laws the Assyrian laws and Mosaic Law These codes come from similar cultures in a relatively small geographical area and they have passages which resemble each other The Code of Hammurabi is the longest surviving text from the Old Babylonian period The code has been seen as an early example of a fundamental law regulating a government i e a primitive constitution The code is also one of the earliest examples of the idea of presumption of innocence and it also suggests that both the accused and accuser have the opportunity to provide evidence
