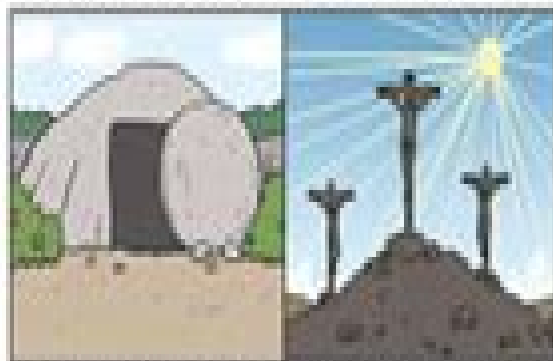
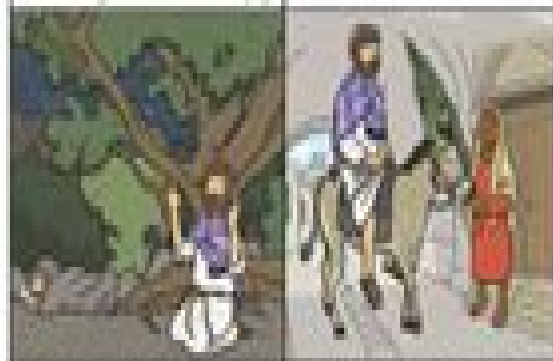


Holy Week Story Sequencing Cards



Many Magicians and another lady went to the tomb where Jesus' body had been laid. When they got there, they saw that the stone had been rolled away. The tomb was empty.

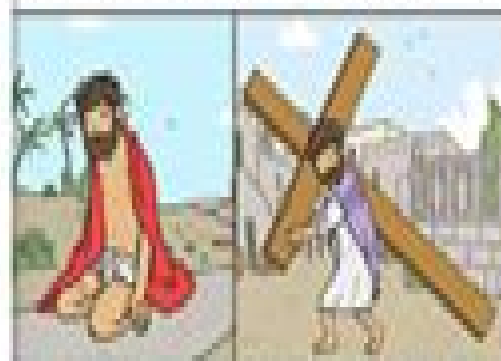
Jesus was nailed upon the cross and placed between two other prisoners. Later that day, the sky turned black and then Jesus cried out to God and died.



Jesus went to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray to God. He asked his disciples to keep watch but instead they fell asleep.

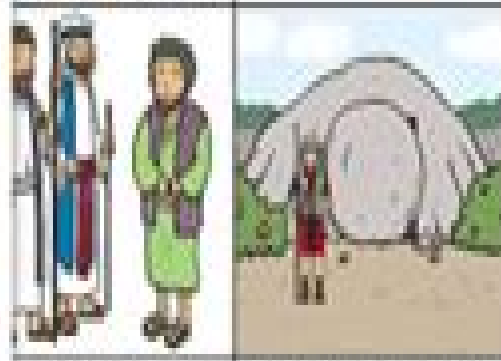
Jesus entered the city of Jerusalem riding on a donkey. Crowds gathered waving palm branches and shouting, 'Hosanna.'
