Stein,1992-01-01 Draws on oral and written testimony to trace the history and evolution of the Shakers set within the broader context of American life The Shaker Village Raymond Bial,2021-12-14 The Shaker faith is estimated to have had a total of fewer than 20 000 members across its 250 year history yet more than 100 000 people visit the various Shaker villages and museums scattered across the eastern United States every year We are still fascinated with the world of the Shakers and authentic examples of Shaker architecture furniture and crafts are prized wherever they remain In The Shaker Village author and photographer Raymond Bial brings readers the history of the Shaker religion and an examination of the Shaker way of life which was based on cooperation and self sufficiency Each Shaker village was built with the goal of creating a heaven on earth for its inhabitants The Shaker people were among the first in America to apply science and new learning directly to traditional farming and homekeeping They invented or improved significantly upon designs of many farm and household items including some still used today the flat broom the slotted spoon the circular saw and the idea of selling gardening seeds in packets Although each Shaker community was self supporting the Shakers success at applying their core values simplicity utility and tranquility carried Shaker villages to a point of abundance they were able to export their beautiful furniture delicious foods and superior wares to the outside world where they have been appreciated ever since The Shaker Village is generously illustrated with Bial s evocative photographs of buildings and artifacts from the Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill Kentucky one of the largest and best preserved Shaker sites The Shaker movement reached its peak in the mid nineteenth century Membership began to drop with the onset of the Civil War and as the new promise of industrialization began to take hold in America Shaker numbers steadily dwindled Although the Shaker religion has all but departed The Shaker Village captures a revelatory glimpse of a legacy that still resounds with modern Americans **Directing the Dance Legacy of Doris Humphrey** Lesley

Clay Lancaster's Kentucky James D. Birchfield, 2021-10-21 Clay Lancaster was infected by a love of architecture at an early age a gentle madness from which he never cared to recover From the Foreword by Roger W Moss It is easy to take for granted the visual environment that we inhabit Familiarity with routes of travel and places of work or leisure leads to indifference and we fail to notice incremental changes When a dilapidated building is eliminated by new development it is forgotten as soon as its replacement becomes a part of our daily landscape When an addition is grafted onto the shell of a house fallen out of fashion or function onlookers might notice at first but the memory of its original form is eventually lost Also forgotten is the use a building once served From historic homes to livestock barns each structure holds a place in the community and can tell us as much about its citizens as their portraits and memoirs Such is the vital yet intangible role that architecture plays in our collective memory Clay Lancaster 1917-2000 began during the Great Depression to document and to encourage the preservation of America's architectural patrimony He was a pioneer of American historic preservation before the movement had a name Although he established himself as an expert on Brooklyn brownstones and California bungalows the nationally known architectural historian also spent four decades photographing architecture in his native Kentucky Lancaster did not consider himself a photographer His equipment consisted of nothing more complex than a handheld camera and his images were only meant for his own personal use in documenting memorable and endangered structures He had the eye of an artist however and recognized the importance of vernacular architecture The more than 150 duotone photographs in Clay Lancaster's Kentucky preserve the beauty of commonplace buildings as well as historic mansions and monuments With insightful commentary by James D Birchfield about the photographs and about Lancaster's work in Kentucky the book documents the many buildings and architectural treasures both existing and long gone whose images and stories remain a valuable part of the state's heritage
