This body of precepts forms the basis for the study of rhetoric the art of human discourse. This book provides a clear understanding of the classical roots of rhetoric. While no single volume can account for every idea developed by the ancients on the art of rhetoric this book seeks to present the concepts that will most effectively provide today's student with a basis
