

# A First Look

## Menus

At the top of the screen you will see several menus. These menus change depending on what application you are using at the moment. It holds most application commands and your keyboard shortcuts (or hot keys) found here. The Apple logo is common to all menus, so its easy to check Computer Information and System Properties at any time.

## Sidebar

The Finder sidebar makes it easy to get to folders on your computer, shared computers on your network, and your recent searches. The folders, applications or files you access most, can be added to the "Favourites" list and they will be visible in every Finder window.

## Cover Flow

Cover Flow lets you see your movies, presentations, PDF files, and more in large size preview as you flip through them.

## Menu extras

In the top left corner of the screen you can find a few options, these little icons are used to quickly add your Mac's settings (networking, connections, Bluetooth devices, volume control, etc), and some system applications.

## Media devices

Mac OS X makes it easy to access the media devices connected to your computer by conveniently putting their icons in the Docking. Mounting an external drive is automatic, and to connect a drive simply right click and then click open.

## Stacks

Stacks provide a convenient way to get to your documents. Folders already in the Dock become stacks automatically. To create a stack, drag a folder of documents to the Dock.

## The Dock

The dock is a convenient way to keep shortcuts to your favorite applications. The symbols in the dock are actually shortcuts to the real applications. Clicking or removing items from the dock will not delete the actual file, only the shortcut to the file. To add an application to the dock, just drag its symbol into the dock. To remove an item, just drag and drop it onto the desktop or trash bin.
