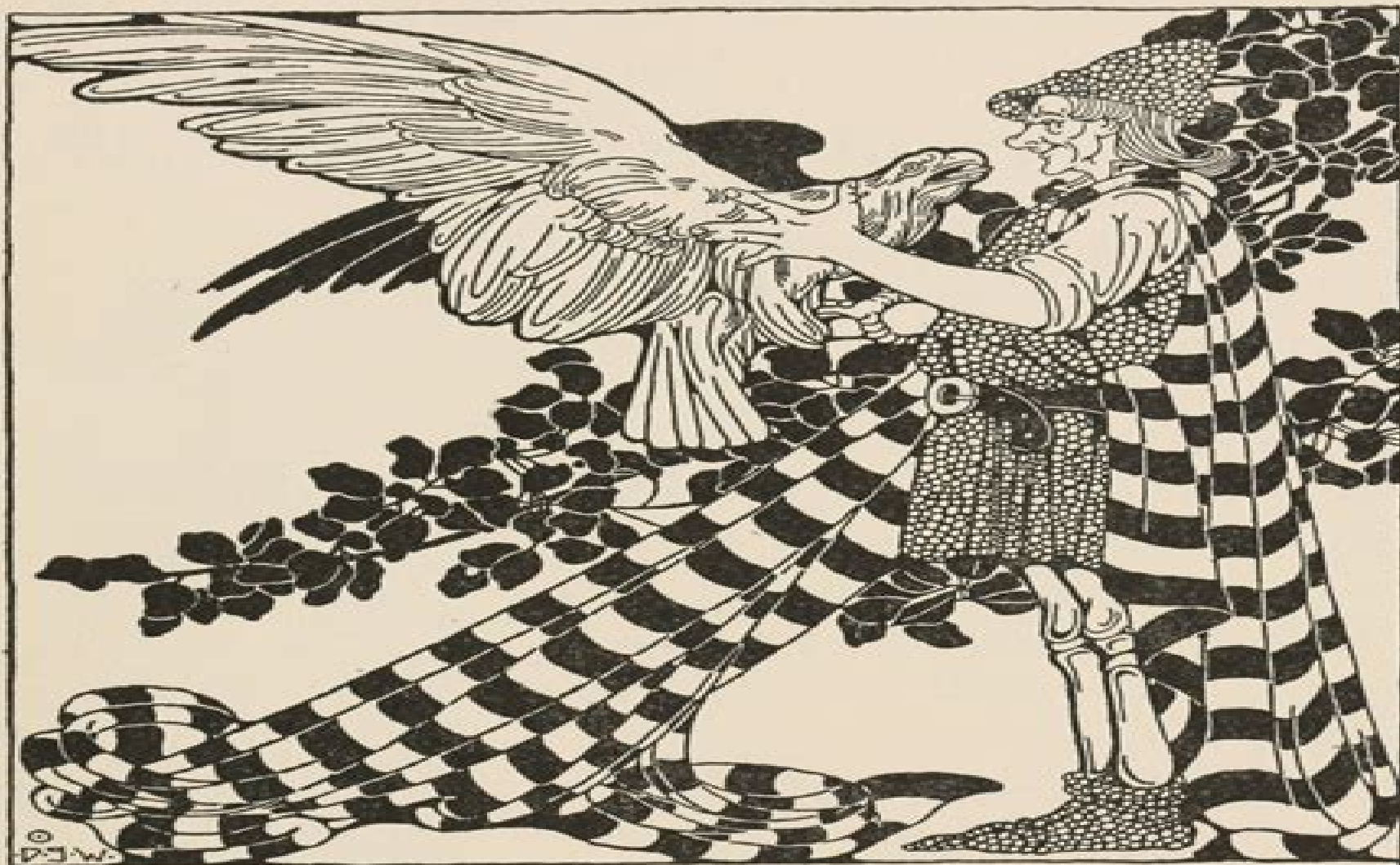

reached tragic proportions Lawrence contends it is critical that we understand the processes by which certain cultural beliefs in combination with observations about the natural history of a particular animal result in emotional and mental responses that may ultimately determine the fate of that species The author argues persuasively that the wren hunt with its ancient roots associated beliefs and complex meanings in the preindustrialized world still has much to teach us
