The Trials of Psychedelic Therapy Matthew Oram, 2018-10-01 The rise and fall of research into the therapeutic potential of LSD After LSD arrived in the United States in 1949 the drug's therapeutic promise quickly captured the interests of psychiatrists In the decade that followed modern psychopharmacology was born and research into the drug's perceptual and psychological effects boomed By the early 1960s psychiatrists focused on a particularly promising treatment known as psychedelic therapy a single carefully guided high dose LSD session coupled with brief but intensive psychotherapy Researchers reported an astounding 50 percent success rate in treating chronic alcoholism as well as substantial improvement in patients suffering from a range of other disorders Yet despite this success LSD officially remained an experimental drug only Research into its effects psychological and otherwise dwindled before coming to a close in the 1970s In *The Trials of Psychedelic Therapy* Matthew Oram traces the early promise and eventual demise of LSD psychotherapy in the United States While the common perception is that LSD's prohibition terminated legitimate research Oram draws on files from the Food and Drug Administration and the personal papers of LSD researchers to reveal that the most significant issue was not the drug's illegality but the persistent question of its efficacy The landmark Kefauver Harris Drug Amendments of 1962 installed strict standards for efficacy evaluation which LSD researchers struggled to meet due to the unorthodox nature of their treatment Exploring the complex interactions between clinical science regulation and therapeutics in American medicine *The Trials of Psychedelic Therapy* explains how an age of empirical research and limited government oversight gave way to sophisticated controlled clinical trials and complex federal regulations Analyzing the debates around how to understand and evaluate treatment efficacy this book will appeal to anyone with an interest in LSD and psychedelics as well as mental health professionals regulators and scholars of the history of psychiatry psychotherapy drug regulation and pharmaceutical research and development

Mysticism Transforming Consciousness Religious Experiences and Voluntary Peasants in Postwar America traces the development of sixties psychedelic mysticism from the deconditioned mind and perennial philosophy of Aldous Huxley to the sacramental ethics of Timothy Leary Richard Alpert and Ralph Metzner to the altruistic religiosity practiced by Stephen Gaskin and The Farm Building directly off the pioneering psychedelic writing of Huxley these psychedelic mystics understood the height of psychedelic consciousness as an existential awareness of unitive oneness a position that offered worldly alternatives to the maladies associated with the postwar moment e g vapid consumerism and materialism lifeless conformity unrelenting racism heightened militarism In opening a doorway to a common world Morgan Shipley locates how psychedelics challenged the coherency of Western modernity by fundamentally reorienting postwar society away from neoliberal ideologies and toward a sacred understanding of reality defined by mutual coexistence and responsible interdependence In 1960s America psychedelics catalyzed a religious awakening defined by compassion expressed through altruism and actualized in projects that sought to ameliorate the conditions of the least advantaged among us In the exact moments that historians and cultural critics often locate as signaling the death knell of the counterculture Gaskin and The Farm emerged not as a response to the perceived failures of the hippies nor as an alternative to sixties politics but in an effort to fulfill the religious obligation to help teach the world how to live more harmoniously Today as we continue to confront issues of socioeconomic inequality entrenched differences widespread violence and the limits of religious pluralism Psychedelic Mysticism serves as a timely reminder of how religion in America can operate as a tool for destabilization and as a means to actively reimagine the very basis of how people relate such a legacy can aid in our own efforts to build a more peaceful sustainable and compassionate world
