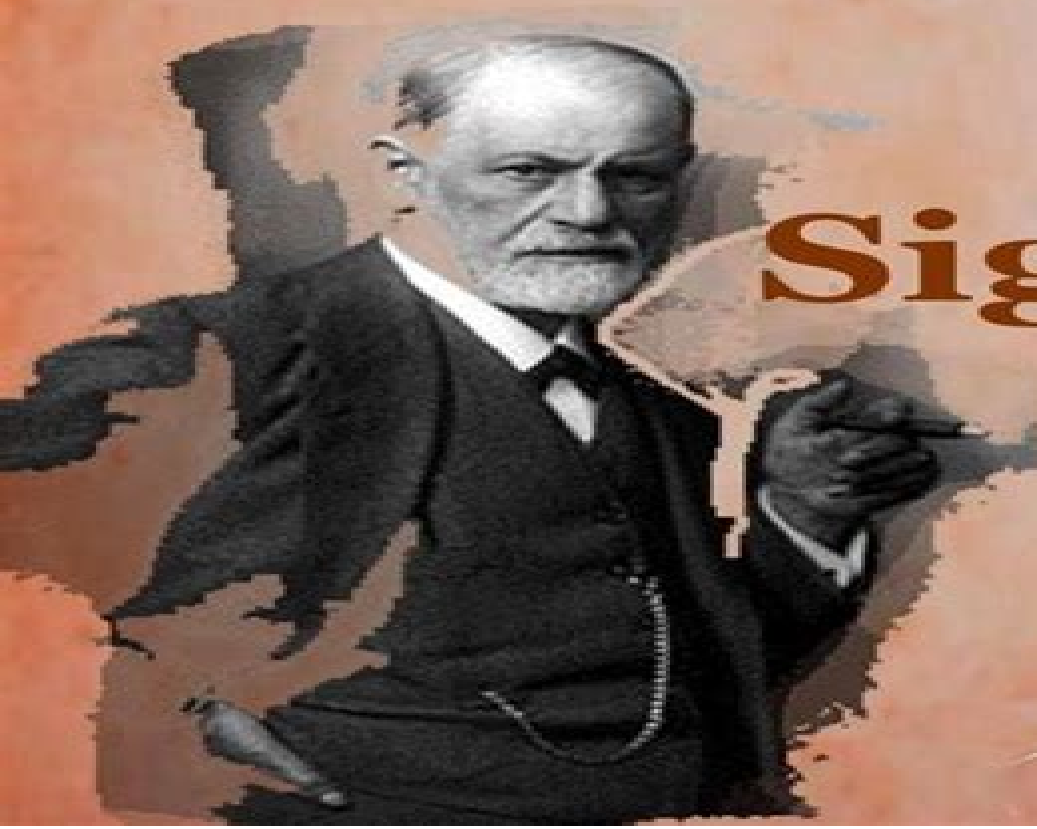

The Poetics of Death Beatrice Martina Guenther,1996-07-12 Traditionally the act of writing constitutes a challenge to the finality of death Yet writing as a subject for literary texts has its own tradition of imagery whose rhetoric is associated with loss rather than immortality The limit of death seems to force a more explicit analysis of the process of writing Writers consider the impact of their work on their readers or re articulate the link between the written text and the subject it is meant to represent Each writer constructs a subversive text The conjunction of writing and death besides highlighting or demystifying the creative act leads in each case to a decidedly critical stance Guenther examines how Kleist's and Balzac's representations of death bring with them a critical awareness that calls attention to the historical context in which the texts are produced

Remains of a Self Cathrine Bjørnholt Michaelsen,2021-06-29 From the twentieth century in the twenty first psychoanalysis and deconstruction have challenged and continue to challenge our conceptions of subjectivity and selfhood Psychoanalysis revealed that even in our innermost households we are never quite alone rather instances of otherness incessantly interfere in our most intimate relation to ourselves forcing us to adapt continuously Deconstruction inheriting both this psychoanalytic disclosure and Heidegger's destruction of the history of metaphysics went to the foundations of the Western constructions of the subject and the self only to find how a destabilizing otherness was always already haunting them What if anything remains of the self in the aftermath Early on in the wake of deconstruction a certain misconceived and simplified notion of the death of the subject was proclaimed and in recent years more or less

successful attempts have been made at reviving the notions of the subject the self and agency In contrast to these attempts at revival this book offers a two pronged approach On the one hand it argues that neither psychoanalysis nor deconstruction propounds a simple annihilation of the subject or liquidation of the self on the other hand however neither do they pave the way for a return to the subject or resurrection of the self that would allow us once again to become confident about our presence to ourselves Instead this book suggests that if we set ourselves the task of taking up the heritage from psychoanalysis and deconstruction in a serious manner we are obliged to retrace the subject and the self as undergoing perpetual auto deconstruction

Moore, 2015-11-19 The notion of sexual sadism emerged from nineteenth century alienist attempts to imagine the pleasure of the torturer or mass killer This was a time in which sexuality was mapped to social progress so that perversions were always related either to degeneration or decadence These ideas were internalized in later Freudian views of the drives within the self and of their repression under the demands of modern European civilization Sadism was always presented as the barbarous past that lurked within each of us ready to burst forth into murderous violence crime anti Semitism and finally genocide This idea maintained its currency in European thought after the Second World War as Freudian influenced accounts of the history of philosophy configured the Marquis de Sade as a kind of Kantian superego in a framework that viewed the Western Enlightenment as unraveled by its own inner demons In this way a straight line was imagined from the late eighteenth century to the Holocaust These ideas have had an ongoing legacy in debates about sexual perversion feminism
