popular culture including *Once Upon a Time* and the *Fables* comic book series. In chapter 4 Schwabe explores the fairy tale dwarf, claiming that adaptations today emphasize the diversity of dwarves' personalities and celebrate the potency of their physicality. *Craving Supernatural Creatures* is a unique contribution to the field of fairy tale studies and is essential reading for students, scholars, and pop culture aficionados alike.

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
