Byers, 2017-06-16 For the author of the fourth Gospel there is neither a Christless church nor a churchless Christ Though John's Gospel has been widely understood as ambivalent toward the idea of church Andrew Byers argues that ecclesiology is as central a Johannine concern as Christology Rather than focusing on the community behind the text John's Gospel directs attention to the vision of community prescribed within the text which is presented as a narrative ecclesiology by which the concept of church gradually unfolds throughout the Gospel's sequence The theme of oneness functions within this script and draws on the theological language of the Shema a centerpiece of early Jewish theology and social identity To be one with this one God and his one Shepherd involves the believers corporate participation within the divine family Such participation requires an ontological transformation that warrants an ecclesial identity expressed by the bold assertion found in Jesus citation of Psalm 82 you are gods

Otherness and Identity in the Gospel of John Sung Uk Lim, 2020-12-23 In this book Sung Uk Lim examines the narrative construction of identity and otherness through ongoing interactions between Jesus and the so called others as represented by the minor characters in the Gospel of John This study reconfigures the otherness of the minor characters in order to reconstruct the identity of Jesus beyond the exclusive binary of identity and otherness The recent trends in Johannine scholarship are deeply entrenched in a dialectical framework of inclusion and exclusion perpetuating positive portrayals of Jesus and negative portrayals of the minor characters Read in this light Jesus is portrayed as a superior omniscient and omnipotent character whereas minor characters are depicted as inferior uncomprehending and powerless At the root of such portrayals lies the belief that the Johannine dualistic *Weltanschauung* warrants such a sharp differentiation between Jesus and the minor characters Lim argues to the contrary that the multiple constructions of otherness deriving from the minor characters make Jesus identity vulnerable to a constant process of transformation Consequently John's minor characters actually challenge and destabilize Johannine hierarchical dualism within a both and framework

Jesus and the Stigmatized Elia Shabani Mligo, 2011-08-01 Biblical scholars often read the Bible with their own interpretive interests in mind without associating the Bible with the concerns of laypeople This largely undermines the contributions laypeople can offer from reading the Bible in their own contexts and from their own life experiences Moreover such exclusively scholarly reading conceals the role of biblical texts in dealing with current social problems such as HIV AIDS related stigmatization Hence the lack of lay participation in the process of Bible reading makes the Bible less visible in various common life situations In this volume Elia

Shabani Mligo draws on his fieldwork among people living with HIV AIDS PLWHA in Tanzania selects stigmatization as his perspective and chooses participant centered contextual Bible study as his method to argue that the reading of texts from the Gospel of John by PLWHA given their lived experiences of stigmatization empowers them to reject stigmatization as unjust Mligo s study shows that Christian PLWHA reject stigmatization because it does not comply with the attitude of Jesus toward stigmatized groups in his own time The theology emerging from the readings by stigmatized PLWHA through their evaluation of Jesus attitudes and acts toward stigmatized people in the texts challenges churches in their obligatory mission as disciples of Jesus Churches are challenged to reconsider healing hospitality and caring prophetic voices against stigmatization and the way they teach about HIV and AIDS in relation to sexuality Churches must revisit their practices toward stigmatized groups and listen to their voices Mligo argues that participant centered Bible study methods similar to the one used in this book whereby stigmatized people are the primary interlocutors in the process can be useful tools in listening to the voices of stigmatized groups

Life in Abundance John R. Donahue, 2005 At his sudden death in August 1998 Raymond E Brown S S was acknowledged internationally as one of the greatest New Testament scholars Writings on the Gospel and Letters of John spanned his whole career In tribute to his life and work St Mary s Seminary and University Baltimore Maryland hosted a conference in October 2003 Life in Abundance The conference did not focus directly on the work of Brown but followed his lead in discussing the state of Johannine studies the relation of John to first century Judaism and Johannine theology and issues of interpretation This volume brings together presentations by scholars on these subjects
