Historic Roswell, Georgia Joe McTyre, Rebecca Nash Paden, 2001 In the 1830s and 1840s low country planters came to Roswell Georgia seeking relief from the heat and malaria that plagued Georgia's golden coast The wealthy plantation owners were attracted to the temperate North Georgia climate by Roswell King a former Glynn County plantation supervisor builder and entrepreneur who promised his friends free land on which to build their homes and stock in the textile mill he built in 1839 The village of Roswell was laid out in 1840 with wide streets a park mills and a residential area and a community founded by devout Presbyterians and hard working industrialists began to take shape By the onset of the Civil War Roswell had two cotton mills a woolen mill and flour and grist mills nearby The town's strategic location near the Chattahoochee River made it a target of Union Gen William T Sherman during his March to the Sea in 1864 While Federal soldiers occupied Roswell that summer none of the grand homes of the town were destroyed Residents persevered the tolls of war and Reconstruction to rebuild mills and strengthen the local economy A small and rural community through the early part of the 20th century Roswell experienced phenomenal growth in the latter half of the century to become a bustling Atlanta suburb yet much of the charm and small town character remains and thousands of tourists are attracted each year by its beautiful antebellum homes and buildings These treasured landmarks are the subject of this engaging retrospective and each snapshot glimpse will illuminate the Roswell of yesteryear

The Georgia Catalog, Historic American Buildings Survey John Linley,1982 From the elegant townhouses of Savannah to the towering hotel and office complexes of Atlanta the state of Georgia has a distinguished architectural tradition No other work documents this rich heritage as comprehensively as The Georgia Catalog Prepared under the auspices of the Historic American Buildings Survey this carefully researched and beautifully illustrated volume will be an invaluable resource for architects preservationists historians and those who own the historic houses or who simply are interested in Georgia s architectural legacy The book is in two parts The first is a history of and guide to the architecture of the state John Linley begins his survey with the remains of prehistoric civilization and the architecture of the first European settlers He traces the development of a native architecture in the state the flowering of the Greek Revival style the functional architecture of commerce and industry and the energy and imagination of urban architecture in the late twentieth century The text reflects the author s interest in the rationale and logic that produced the architecture and in the lessons that the past has for the present and the future He also emphasizes the influence of climate ecology landscape and city planning on both historic and contemporary architecture The second section of The Georgia Catalog is a complete updated listing of nearly four hundred sites in the Historic American Buildings Survey Each entry gives the precise location of the site a brief description of the structure the date of construction and the name of the architect if known changes in name structure or location of the building its present condition any facts of historical significance and the number and dates of drawings photographs and data sheets in the HABS collection at the Library of Congress To add to its value as a guide the volume also includes a glossary of architectural terms and a list of Georgia properties that are included in the National Register of Historic Places have been designated National Landmarks or are part of the Historic American Engineering Record

Florida where they profited from the wrecking trade set up business operations at various points along the eastern coast of the United States and eventually made a significant impact on some of the less developed areas of Georgia The most important member of the family was Nelson Tift a pioneer businessman who founded the city of Albany Georgia in the 1830s and played a major role on behalf of his adopted state during the Civil War and Reconstruction His enterprises were often coordinated with his brother Asa in Key West Their nephew Henry Harding Tift founded Tifton and Tift County and Tift College in Forsyth was named for Henry s wife Bessie a major benefactor Later Tifts were not only involved in the continued development of Albany and Tifton but made significant contributions to the economy and civic life of Macon Atlanta and other communities The most important theme embodied in this monograph is how the Tifts brought Connecticut Yankee values to the South but were in turn transformed into Southerners The Tifts of Georgia is richly illustrated with charts maps and original photographs This history of an important Georgia family should be of special interest to professional and amateur historians sociologists cultural anthropologists and genealogists
