COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is intended to serve as an introduction to public policymaking processes in the United States with special emphasis on the formation of public policy. During the course of the semester we will cover multiple theories about the policy formation process and discuss the many actors that help shape policy outcomes. Course readings, in-class exercises, and group discussions will allow us to apply these general concepts to specific policy areas. Some of our discussions will focus on socially, politically, or morally controversial topics. These discusses are designed to help students appreciate a diversity of perspectives, as well as to help students critically evaluate policy positions. By the end of the semester students should be well versed in the basic facets of policymaking and should be well equipped to pursue more advanced courses in public policy.
