HEYDENREICH: *Sie beschäftigen sich mit den Beziehungen zwischen Physik und Literatur bereits seit sehr langer Zeit. Wie zahlreichen Essays und fiktionalen Prosatexten zu entnehmen ist, begleitet Sie diese Thematik schon seit vielen Jahren. Seit dem 1990 Ihr Roman »Freigang« erschienen ist, ist Ihre Begeisterung für diese beiden augenscheinlich diametral entgegengesetzten Themenbereiche auch uns und einem breiten Publikum bekannt. Könnten Sie uns wichtige Stationen und Wegmarken Ihres Denkens über dieses Verhältnis schildern?*

WOELK: Nun, die naturwissenschaftliche Ebene und das Interesse daran waren bei mir schon immer da – auch im Hinblick auf meine schulische Laufbahn. Das Geschichtenerzählen kam dann durch meine Beschäftigung mit Literatur, wie zum Beispiel mit dem »Steppenwolf« im Alter von 14, 15 Jahren hinzu. Man fängt natürlich nicht gleich an, über diese beiden Bereiche in ihrer umfassenden Komplexität nachzudenken. Zunächst war dies mehr eine friedliche Koexistenz zweier Materien, die mich faszinierten. Ich begann dann auf der einen Seite die kanonischen Werke der Literatur zu lesen, auf der anderen Seite habe ich Physik studiert und dann sehr bald aber angefangen, selbst literarisch zu arbeiten. Dies natürlich immer unter Vorbehalt, denn retrospektiv gesehen haben jene Texte, die in der Anfangszeit entstanden, natürlich noch nicht das Niveau, das man später an sich selbst stellt. Jedenfalls waren schon immer die Versuche da, mit Texten zu arbeiten. Dazu kam eine intensive Beschäftigung mit der europäischen Philosophie. Die Verbindung zwischen Physik und Philosophie ist offensichtlich, weil sich diese beiden Bereiche mit der Konstitution der Welt befassen, um diese irgendwie in den Griff zu bekommen. Für mich war klar, dass zwischen den beiden Gebieten eine enge Verbindung besteht. So habe ich zunächst in diesen Disziplinen danach gefahndet, wie sich möglicherweise philosophische Aspekte in physikalischen Sachverhalten und Theorien wiederfinden – und umgekehrt.

Als Stichwort möchte ich hier die Quantenmechanik nennen – ein Thema, das bis heute aktuell ist. Die Frage nämlich, inwieweit wir durch unsere Anwesenheit als Beobachter die Welt in ihrer Art verändern. Ohne jetzt tiefer darauf eingehen zu wollen, ist bei der Beschäftigung mit solch elementaren physikalischen Fragen der Weg zur Philosophie schnell eingeschlagen. Mit Philosophie habe ich mich in

Dimri, 2015-11-21 This book deals with fractals in understanding problems encountered in earth science and their solutions It starts with an analysis of two classes of methods homogeneous fractals random models and homogeneous source distributions or one point distributions widely diffused in the geophysical community especially for studying potential fields and their related source distributions Subsequently the use of fractals in potential fields is described by scaling spectral methods for estimation of curie depth The book also presents an update of the use of the fractal concepts in geological understanding of faults and their significance in geological modelling of hydrocarbon reservoirs Geophysical well log data provide a unique description of the subsurface lithology here the Detrended Fluctuation Analysis technique is presented in case studies located off the west coast of India Another important topic is the fractal model of continuum percolation which quantitatively reproduce the flow path geometry by applying the Poiseuille s equation The pattern of

fracture heterogeneity in reservoir scale of natural geological formations can be viewed as spatially distributed self similar tree structures here the authors present simple analytical models based on the medium structural characteristics to explain the flow in natural fractures The Fractal Differential Adjacent Segregation F DAS is an unconventional approach for fractal dimension estimation using a box count method The present analysis provides a better understanding of variability of the system adsorbents adsorbate interactions Towards the end of book the authors discuss multi fractal scaling properties of seismograms in order to quantify the complexity associated with high frequency seismic signals Finally the book presents a review on fractal methods applied to fire point processes and satellite time continuous signals that are sensitive to fire occurrences
