Nock, 1992 Historic Railway Disasters Oswald Stevens Nock, 1983 **Historic Railway Disasters** Oswald Stevens Nock, Basil Knowlman Cooper, 1987 Accidents in History, 2020-01-29 There is now an extensive literature on the social and environmental consequences of living in the risk society Studies of trauma are also increasingly prominent But scant attention has been paid to perceptions of risk and danger in the past in particular to the history of accidents and the meanings of the accidental This collection of interdisciplinary essays addresses this lacuna providing a theoretically informed historical sociology of the accident and risk It explores the social and cultural contexts in which acts of God calamities catastrophes disasters injuries casualties and other category of mishaps were experienced conceptualized and responded to Drawing on the skills of British European and North American scholars Accidents in History combines philosophical sociological and ecological overviews with in depth historical case studies It spans the period from the eighteenth century to the present probing the epistemological social and political roots of the accidental The authors differentiate between industrial and other forms of injury trace the origins of the normalization of accidents and analyze the interactions and gendered discrepancies between domestic and non domestic mishaps They also investigate the medicalization of sudden injury and discuss the emergence of new socio medical and humanitarian discourses around the organization of relief for victims **Historic Disasters of East Tennessee** Dewaine A. Speaks, 2019 For more than 150 years East Tennesseans have experienced disasters of historic proportions The 1902 Fraterville Mine explosion took the lives of 216 men and boys A 1904 head on passenger train wreck in New Market claimed the lives of 64 In 1906 Jellico was practically destroyed by the explosion of a train car loaded with dynamite Floodwaters near Rockwood in 1929 took the lives of 7 Boy Scouts and their Scoutmaster An explosion in 1960 at Kingsport s Eastman plant killed 16 workers and injured 400 In 2016 a fire in the Great Smoky Mountains claimed the lives of 14 while destroying 2 460 buildings Knoxville author Dewaine Speaks chronicles these and other historic tragedies in East Tennessee **British Railway Disasters** Robin Jones, 2019-12-01 This is the story of how Britain s railway disasters horrific though they may be change the network for the better through the crucial lessons that are learned It starts with fatalities on early mining tramways before the dawn of the steam age and takes the story up to the present day While many of Britain s worst tragedies are covered in depth such as Quintinshill in 1915 and Harrow Wealdstone in 1952 the book also looks at others that had resounding consequences for safety *Railroad Wrecks* Edgar A. and applicable in rail operations everywhere The ultimate purpose therefore has been to determine universal railroad safety doctrines the application of which will lessen the frequency and severity of future rail accidents and thereby reduce death tolls passenger and employee injuries and the attendant financial and material losses Covered herein in concise form are the accounts of 70 major rail disasters in the United States and 111 train catastrophes in various foreign countries Included for quick reference are two tabulations showing pertinent particulars for all the railroad disasters treated in this volume The reader if he peruses this long list of wreck narratives will acquire a unique understanding of the widespread incident of rail accidents and perhaps arrive at a personal judgment on how to best further the noble cause of accident prevention Certainly he will gain an eye opening view of the dreadful scope of the long term operational misfortunes that have plagued the mighty Iron Horse More than one hundred photographs taken at the scenes of the accidents illustrate this volume A substantial introduction elucidates the history of railroading in relation to death dealing mishaps operating safeguards railroad personnel the human factor the grade crossing dilemma rail unions and worker discipline safety research efforts code of railroad working rules alcohol and drug problems the Harriman safety awards the legendary rail cabooses and accident prevention guidelines The eleven part appendix includes a historical statistical review of safety on the United States railroads and reports on the horrendous Louisville Nashville Railroad hazardous materials spillage at Crestview Florida on 8 April 1970 Also summarized are the rail accident prevention philosophies practiced on four foreign railway systems

The Early History of Railway Tunnels Hubert Pragnell, 2024-08-30 To the early railway traveller the prospect of travelling to places in hours rather than days hitherto was an inviting prospect however a journey was not without its fears as well as excitement To some the prospect of travelling through a tunnel without carriage lighting with smoke permeating the compartment and the confined noise was a horror of the new age What might happen if we broke down or crashed into another train in the darkness To others it was exciting with the light from the footplate flickering against the tunnel walls or spotting the occasional glimpses of light from a ventilation shaft To the directors of early railway companies planning a route was governed by expense and the most direct way Avoiding hills could

add miles but tunnelling through them could involve vast expense as the Great Western Railway found at Box and the London and Birmingham at Kilsby Creating a cutting as an alternative was also costly not only in labour and time but also in compensation for landowners who opposed railways on visual and social grounds having seen their land divided by canals Construction involved millions of bricks or blocks of stone for sufficiently thick walls to withstand collapse However the entrance barely seen from the carriage window might be an impressive Italianate arch as at Primrose Hill or a castellated portal worthy of the Middle Ages as at Bramhope This book sets out to tell the story of tunnelling in Britain up to about 1870 when it was a question of burrowing through earth and rock with spade and explosive powder with the constant danger of collapse or flooding leading to injury and death It uses contemporary accounts from the dangers of railway travel by Dickens to the excitement of being drawn through the Liverpool Wapping Tunnel by the young composer Mendelssohn It includes descriptions from early railway company guide books newspapers and diaries It also includes numerous photographs and colored architectural elevations from railway archives
