Shortly after her release, she published *Women Without Men* and was arrested and jailed again this time for her frank and defiant portrayal of women's sexuality. While still banned in Iran, the novel became an underground bestseller there and has been translated into many languages around the world. Parsipur is also the author of *Touba* and *The Meaning of Night* among many other books and now lives in exile in northern California.
